Chapter 2 The Lord Yahweh / Jehovah

- Originally written without vowels yhw and not spoken
 - Translated to mean I Am - a constant God, always there, an eternal God.
 - Self-existent and self-sufficient
 - Unchangeable, the God who is God, the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit
 - From everlasting to everlasting
 - God is a mystery but the Spirit of God is ever revealing Himself to us
1. Jehovah- means life, to live (chavah)
 2. King James writes it as Lord, the revealing one in the present tense.
 3. Jehovah, I AM, Exo. 3:14
 4. Jehovah as pure righteousness and holiness, Exo. 32:1
 5. Story of Moses and how he grew to know God in intimacy and talked to God like a son and begged God like a friend and had great favor but used it to intercede for the people, a priestly role Jesus has given us
 6. Taking on the priestly role allows Jehovah to live in me and reveal Himself to others through me
 7. Isa. 45:21, Psa. 103:17, Zech. 13:9, Psa. 139:5

Chapter 3 The Lord is God Jehovah - Elohim

- Genesis 1:26; Let us make man in our own image in our likeness giving the dominion over all
 - us refers to the Trinity; Father, son and Holy Spirit
 - Elohim- reflecting divine majesty and power, the plural of majesty
 - Gen. 2:4, Gen. 3:21, Exo. 9:30, Exo. 20:4-6
1. In the beginning God created, this word God means El or Elohim
 2. Occurs over 2500 times in the Bible
 3. Abraham knew God through covenant! He knew God would come though for him
 4. Covenant; Psalm 91:2-4, 57:1-3, Jeremiah 32:38-40, 1 Kings 8:23
 5. Joel, means the lord is God; the book of Joel

Chapter 4 The Lord God Most High Jehovah Elyon

- Old Testament over 40 times and literally means supreme God or most loved God
- Gen. 14:2-23,
- 1 Corin. 2:9
- 1. My personality is fragmented and God has a plan to complete it.
- 2. Use the names of God to replace the missing elements in my life to complete myself with Him
- 3. This name carries great authority on my behalf
- 4. Means alah; to go up, climb, exalt, no god higher than my God
- 5. This is the name that satan coveted; Isa. 14:13,14
- 6. Story of Balaam; God always has the last word
- 7. Four P's.
 - a. Purpose in our hearts to trust, serve, and obey
 - b. Prayed to God
 - c. Perception; getting God's view point on the matter comes thru prayer
 - d. Power
- 8. In Psalm we see 18:13-17 He is our voice of victory
- 9. In Psalm we see 21:7 he is our security and stability
- 10. In Psalm we see 57:2 He performs and accomplishes all on our behalf
- 11. In Psalm we see 78:35 God and Jesus are One, Redeemer
- 12. In Psalm we see 82:6 we are His children
- 13. In psalm we see 91:1-9 awesome verses
- 14. New Testament Philipians 2:5-9; ... a name which is above every name..
- 15. In Ephesians we see we are his body and set apart, lifted up with Him
- 16. Any Scripture that has High God refers to El Elyon

Chapter 5 The Almighty God El-Shaddai

- Gen. 17:1-3, God is God almighty in spite of my circumstances
- I am only as weak as I confess to be
- 11 Corin 4:7, God works with earthen vessels
- Gen. 49:23-25. 43:14,
- I must be willing to be Crazy for His sake, absurd for the Lord. 1 Corin. 4:10

- Matt. 19:26, with God all things are possible
 - Our faith increases as we realize that God is so great
1. Gen. 17 first, many breasted one
 2. Almighty always relates to blessings and multiplication
 3. John 10:10, Psa. 91:2
 4. Used 48 times and 30 of those in Job
 5. Naomi in the book of Ruth
 6. Eph. 3:19-21, John 15:2, 16

Chapter 6 The Lord will Provide Jehovah Jireh

- Gen 21:33, Abraham was learning the character of God
 - Luke 22:35, Jesus told His disciples of Father God's provision
 - 11 Corin. 9:8-10
 - Revealed in a severe test with Abram and Isaac; Gen. 21:33
 - The will of God is simply Pray, Hear and Obey
 - God reveals and then gives us a choice to follow
 - God will supply seed and He will multiply it by bringing fruit to it
 - James 3:18
 - He provides both now and in eternity
1. Jehovah, the revealing One.
 2. First compound word use to describe God
 3. Abraham lifted up his eyes. There are times when God wants to give me something and I must be spiritually keen to perceive and receive it.
 4. Hold fast my confession of faith. My words will create miracles
 5. God has prepared every provision that I will need and every thing in me that is necessary for the call and the plan
 6. God's perfect provision for us is Jesus!!!

Chapter 7 The Lord is Healer Jehovah Rapha

- Exo. 15:25-26, first revealed as their Healer
- With conditions
- Love the benefits, but the conditions are so hard....
- Look to Christ; Num. 21:5, John 12:32
- God wants His children to be healthy

- Don't make pain your god
- We have the choice as to what to do with our lives, choose life

Chapter 8 The Lord is our Righteousness Jehovah Tsidqenu

- Right standing with God through Christ
 - Honoring God with our hearts
 - Fearing God enough to obey him
 - Holiness is a condition of the heart
 - Sing a new song with Him
 - Be righteous conscience not sin conscience
1. Jeremiah 23:5-6
 2. Psalm 119:142,144, Jeremiah 17:9, Isaiah 61:10, robe of righteousness
 3. II Corinthians 5:17, 18,21, James 5:16, Galatians 2:20; the past is gone
 4. I John 1:9, repentance brings righteousness!!
 5. Rom. 6:17,18 ; 10:3,4, I Corinthians 1:30, Isa. 53:11

Chapter 9 The Lord of Hosts Jehovah Tsebaoth

- Warring, to wage war, first mentioned in Gen. 2:1
 - Michael the arch angel a warring angel
 - He informs us as to how to stand to exact victory
 - Hannah prayed to the Lord of Hosts, I Samuel 1:11
 - Isaiah 14:27
 - I Sam. 17:45-47, David declared that he came in the name of the Lord of Hosts against Goliath
 - God has a captain in the army, Jesus, Joshua 5:13-15; not an angel but the Lord Himself
 - Our warfare is spiritual it tells us so in Ephesians 6:12
 - Satan's only weapon against man is deception (?? is this so Lord, he is the father of lies, which is deception)
 - Warfare intensified, so is the anointing
 - Haggai 2:6-9
1. We have been appointed a place in the army of the Lord
 2. Judges 5; Deborah and Barak

3. God turned time back and stopped the sun, commanded birds to feed Elisha, shut the mouth of lions, blinded the Syrian army
4. Scriptures: Neh. 9:6, Psalms 103:21, Isaiah 6:3, 40:26, Romans 9:29, James 5:4

Chapter 10 The Lord is Conqueror Jehovah Nissi, my Banner

- My Banner, the Lord is my sign of conquest
 - A name given due to a happening at a place, war with Amalek, Esau's decedents, the Amalakites. The first battle the Israelites experienced after leaving Egypt
 - Exo. 17:15-16; Aaron and Hur lifted up the arms of Moses while Joshua led the Israelites in battle against the Amalakites.
 - Letting God go first as the banner assures victory
 - We have victory-4, over: sin, habit slavery, self, sorrow
1. I must see myself only in Him
 2. Banner: to glisten, a pole or ensign, a standard or miracle
 3. Isa. 13:2-4, 11 / Isa. 11:1,10
 4. Ehp. 6, war not against flesh and blood, put on the whole armor..
 5. God goes before me and I will win, I cannot go without God and expect to win in my own strength.

Chapter 11 The Lord is Peace Jehovah Shalom

- Given after another place incident
 - The power of praise, praising Him for what He has already done
 - Judges 6:24, Gideon called it, the place, Jehovah Shalom
 - He is the same God to me; Heb. 13:8
 - We can have peace in every area of our lives
1. Phil. 4:6-7
 2. Shalom: used 170 times, means full, to render payment and perfect
 3. Isaiah 9:6, Jesus is the Prince of Peace
 4. There is a peace offering
 5. Jerusalem is the city of peace
 6. Jeremiah 29:11
 7. Isaiah 66:12; peace like a river, always in a plural form, the many blessings of God

8. Means Eriene, my sister Irene, means to live life at its best! Ha, to pray this over her.
9. Ephesians 6:15; our feet are shod with the Gospel of Peace
10. Col. 3:15; Let the Peace of God rule in my heart
11. Isaiah 26:3, I will stay in perfect peace if my mind is stayed on Jesus
12. Rom. 8:6; to be spiritually minded is to be life and peace
13. Nothing will shake me up if I am dwelling in the peace of God
14. John 14:27=29; Jesus speaking, Peace I give to you...
15. Matt. 11:28-29, take my yoke upon you
16. Phil. 4:7,

Chapter 12 The Lord is There Jehovah Shammah

- Ezekiel 48:35
 - Reveals much about the nature of God and the nature of the Bride of Christ
 - God chooses to dwell, in us, in our homes, in our families, in our church
 - Rev. 22:5
 - He is already living among us
 - The Lord lives in me
 - Psa. 119:151, Isaiah 50:7-8, 55:6
1. God desires fellowship with his people
 2. God told Israel even after they were taken captive, I will never leave you
 3. Hebrews tells us he will never leave or forsake us
 4. I Corinthians 3:16 / II Corinthians 6:16
 5. Colossians 1:27; Christ in me the hope of glory. Glory always refers to the presence of God the Shekinah, meaning God living in me.
 6. Eph. 2:19-22
