The goal of the SPK/JWH Scholarship - “Get A Ride For Doing It Right” is to provide financial support for graduating seniors from Greencastle-Antrim and James Buchanan High School who plan to attend an accredited technical/career school, two or four year college or university with focus on a trade, the sciences, aviation, or technology. *A recipient from each school will receive a \$1500 scholarship.*

About The Scholarship

The “Get a Ride for Doing it Right” memorial scholarship was established by Mary Pat Kulina shortly after the death of her husband, Stephen in November 2009 and her father, James William Hane in June 2009. The scholarship is intended to continue their legacy as a lasting remembrance of how each day should be valued, embraced and lived to the fullest. It is an opportunity to reward those who are doing it right; have a passion for learning and recognize the true wealth to be obtained by living life to its fullest.

Applicants should complete the attached Questionnaire and include all attachments and return to the Foundation by the deadline date. **ALL** applications must be submitted by mail and **RECEIVED** by the deadline. No exceptions will be made for applications not received by that date.

A Selection Committee will choose finalists from all applicants. The selection of the recipients will be announced in April.

ELIGIBILITY: High School Seniors who will graduate from Greencastle-Antrim School District and James Buchanan School District. An equal number of scholarships will be awarded to each district.

Part 2: Attach a copy of your high school transcript.

Part 3: Attach a one-page, single-spaced (12 pt font) essay addressing your future plans; career interests and why you selected post-secondary education in a trade, science, aviation, or technology related field; describe how you exhibit a passion for learning; and what it means to “value, embrace and live each day to the fullest.

Part 4: Attach two letters of recommendation from a teacher or community leaders that speak to your character, your strengths and how investing in your education will enhance these traits.

Part 5: Please provide a copy of your technical/college school acceptance letter or an explanation of why one is not included in this application.

Part 6: As a recipient of the scholarship, availability to attend an annual scholarship fundraising event. If recipient is unable to attend they must be represented by a parent, guardian, or family member that can read a letter on their behalf regarding their progress. The legacy of recipients of this award is of keen interest to supporters of the foundation.
