



CALL FOR JOURNALISTS

EURO-MEDITERRANEAN YOUTH PARLIAMENT 2013

The 2013 Euro-Mediterranean Youth Parliament (EMYP) is looking for talented young (current or aspiring) **journalists aged between 20-26** who are interested in becoming part of its media team for the event, taking place from **23-30 June**, in **Stockholm**.

The aim of the conference is to provide young engaged citizens of the Euro-Med region the opportunity to come together and cooperate to come up with ideas and projects stretching beyond their geographical and cultural borders, that can contribute to the shaping of their future societies.

The role of the media team is to add another dimension to the event by producing interesting and insightful **feature videos**, written articles and quality reportages examining and highlighting the themes and issues under discussion. At the same time, the work of the media team will demonstrate the important role that media can have in creating, sustaining and enhancing civil society beyond land borders. Those selected will have the unforgettable and rewarding opportunity to engage and report on the work of outstanding and active youth leaders from Middle Eastern and European societies.

The EMYP media team will be looking to work across a variety of media platforms during the session: video (making and editing video), online (blogging and social media) and print (writing and editing text, layout). As far as possible, we are looking for versatile journalists able to contribute to the more than one area, but would like applicants to declare which area they consider themselves experts in and provide examples of the work they have done in that field. Good photography skills would be a bonus.

Please keep in mind that we will ask all journalists to arrive in Stockholm **one day earlier, by noon on June 22nd (12.00pm)**, in order to participate in our training day. Also, please remember that we will not cover flight costs to Stockholm, but all main meals and accommodation costs will be covered by EMYP.

In order to apply, we kindly ask you to send a CV, completed application form and attach at least 3 examples of previous work to mediateam@eup.se by Monday, May 13th.

Essential:

- Journalism experience, preferably in a professional environment
- Excellent written and spoken English
- Technical skills necessary for their specialist area (e.g. video making and editing skills for video role, knowledge of layout software for print role)
- Ability to work creatively under pressure
- An interest in the societal issues facing the Euro-Mediterranean region

Desirable:

- Experience of projects that serve civil society and are passionate about societal issues facing the Euro-Mediterranean region
- Good photography skills
