Carrying small quantities however may not be an issue. You may contact your local Customs Headquarters for a certificate granting permission that is valid for all your travel in one year.

The currencies that are advisable to spend in Thailand are either Thai Bahts or US Dollars, and you may plan to bring either, according to your requirements.
