MEREDITH Greenham is riding a new wave of momentum all the way to Antwerp thanks to a Mosman exercise and lifestyle coach.

Ms Greenham, 41, has been seeing specialists for a degenerative spinal condition since she was 16.

But after seeking help from Leila Lutz, owner of Mosman business Momentum for Life, she is now preparing to compete in archery at the Outgames.

A year ago she was advised to take up archery to help her spine condition.

Archery involves a lot of strain on the spine so she consulted a health and fitness expert Leila Lutz.

"When Meredith first

came to me, whenever she held the bow she had a horrible contortion in her spine.

Ms Lutz helped her develop a comprehensive program involving exercise but also focusing on managing diet and other factors such as emotional stress.

Since then Ms Greenham has progressed from an 18lb bow to a 32lb one and is about to enter her first competition.

The Outgames, an initiative of the LGBT community, will be held in Antwerp this year with archery on August 6-7.
