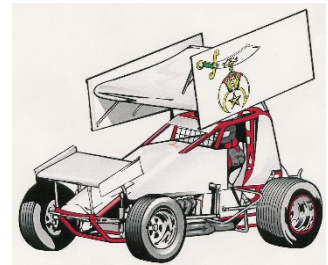

General Guidelines

The following are a set of guidelines that is not intended to be all inclusive. For a complete listing of unit guidelines, please refer to the unit By-Laws.

1. An applicant of the unit cannot own a car until they have been in the unit for a probationary period of at least 6-months, met the 70% attendance guideline during the 6-month probationary period, AND have been voted into the unit by the unit membership. The applicant CAN however, operate a unit vehicle once all dues and initiation fees have been paid.
2. While the unit is not a “STAG” unit, there are certain events that are for “members only”, which means that wives/significant others are not invited to attend/participate. Below are examples of what to expect (lists are not all inclusive):
 - A. **Members Only events:** In-session unit meetings, overnight parades (other than Temple Functions – i.e. Midwest, Imperial), and other designated events as dictated.
 - B. **Open attendance events:** Non-overnight parades, family events such as picnics and pizza parties, annual Christmas Party, observing driving practices, wedding dances, fundraisers, Ceremonials, Midwest, Imperial, and any other open attendance Temple events.
3. An applicant may be asked to withdraw their application from the Unit at any time during their 6-month probationary period for any reason.

Items for purchase

The following are items that are available for purchase (Required or Optional), location of where the item can be purchased, member cost, and who should be paid for the item.

1. **Parade Polo (Required)** – Each unit member will receive one (1) when they join the unit (cost is covered by initial fees). Any additional shirts need to be purchased from the Unit. Member Cost \$20, payable to the Unit.
2. **Unit Pullover (Optional)** – Can be purchased at Midstates Inc., 935 E. 8th St. Member Cost approx. \$ 40, payable to Midstates Inc.
3. **Class A Shirt (Required for Imperial, Midwest and Ceremonials)** - Member Cost approx. \$40, payable to the Unit.
4. **Class A Pants and Belt (Required for Imperial, Midwest and Ceremonials)** - Can be purchased at Velvet Uniforms, 2810 W. 3rd St. Member Cost \$20, payable to the Unit.
5. **Parade Hat (Required)** – Can be purchased from the Unit. Member Cost \$15, payable to the Unit.
