In 2012 he was invited to speak about working in the piano/voice setting at a summer program in Kiefersfelden, Germany. A trio recording with vocalist Laura Grill and bass player Brad Barrett, a duo record of original music with guitarist Garry Elliott, and his solo piano album, *Open Arms*. He currently teaches privately and at Carleton University.
