## Children, Youth and Family Services

Community Connection, for children and youth in schools and community-based sites, began serving youth in juvenile detention centers this year. Family Connection expanded into Collin County and added several new sites. Through the array of services offered through both of these programs, a total of **14,881 children and youth were positively impacted by Rainbow Days this past year**. Children and youth learned important life skills and received emotional support from their caring adult staff mentors the following programs:

- Weekly Curriculum-Based Support Groups (CBSGs®)
- Red Ribbon Week Activities
- Classroom-Based Presentations
- Summer Day Camps – including Kids' University, Camp Bravo! and Outdoor Adventure Camp
- Family Outings – including Saturday with Santa and Back-to-School Celebration
- Leadership Connection, Mentored Arts Retreats and much more!

They recruited over 60 member in this first year and conducted a variety of fun and engaging events for membership, including: social, service and fundraising! - Organizational Capacity Building

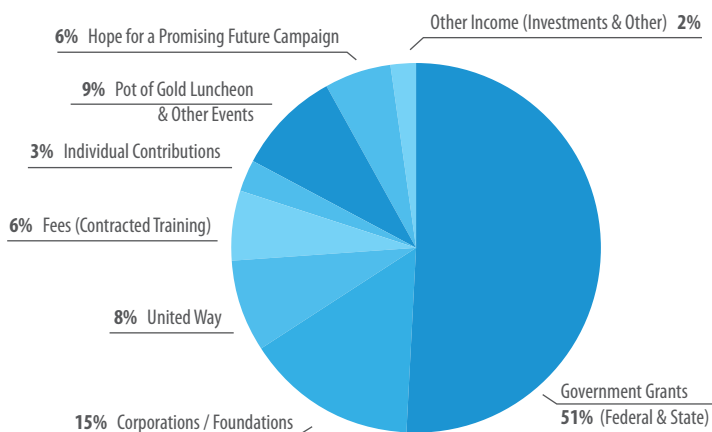
## Volunteers

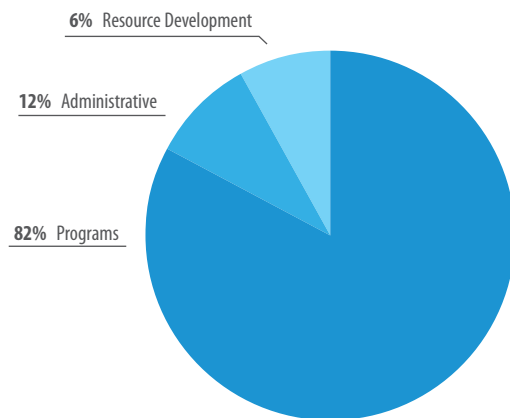


## Summary of Revenue and Expenses for the Year Ending August 31, 2013
