In 2012, Rainbow Days celebrated 30 years of serving children.

## Children, Youth and Family Services

A total of **15,322 children and youth** learned important life skills and received emotional support from their caring adult staff mentors through Rainbow Days' services. Rainbow Days' staff traveled on site to serve these vulnerable children, youth and families at one of **86 partner organizations** in the Dallas area, including schools, recreation centers, shelters and other community-based sites. Key programs included:

- Weekly Curriculum-Based Support Groups (CBSGs®)
- Red Ribbon Week Activities
- Classroom-Based Presentations
- Summer Day Camps – including Kids' University, Camp Bravo! and Outdoor Adventure Camp
- Family Outings – including Saturday with Santa, Easter Eggstravagana and Back-to-School Celebration
- Leadership Connection, Mentored Arts Retreats and much more!

## Training Services

Rainbow Days expands the scope and impact of our local direct service programs in Dallas by training other youth-serving professionals across Texas and the U.S. to positively impact the lives of the children they serve. Using innovative and effective training, Rainbow Days' Training Services Division is able to equip individuals to pursue excellence as they strive to help the children, youth and families they serve. In 2012, **2,130 educators, volunteers and other youth service professionals** received training in one or more of the following:

- Curriculum-Based Support Group (CBSG®) Program
- Prevention Programs for Classroom-Based Settings
- In-person Workforce Development Workshops
- Online Workforce Development Webinars
- Organizational Capacity Building

## Donors

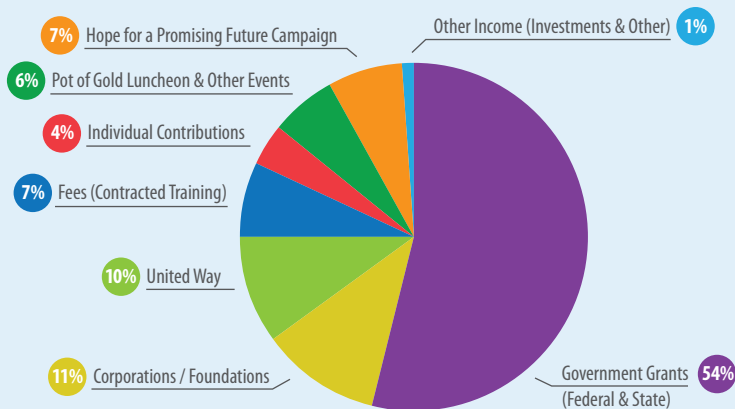
