March 1, 2017 Original application must be received BY MAIL by a local RWF unit.

March 22, 2017 Each local RWF unit will select winner(s) by March 21st. (Please note a unit may or may not offer a monetary award.) The First Place winner for each unit will be forwarded to their County for LEVEL 2 scholarship consideration.

April 12, 2017 A First and Second Place winner will be selected from each of the seven Counties. (Please note a County may or may not offer a monetary award.) The First Place winners will be forwarded to CFRW-Southern Division for LEVEL 3 scholarship consideration.

May 3, 2017 1st Place and 2nd Place winners will be selected to receive the CFRW-Southern Division Charlotte Mousel Scholarship award.

July TBD, 2017 1st Place and 2nd Place winners of the CFRW-Southern Division Charlotte Mousel Scholarship will be invited to attend a luncheon in Pomona, CA, where they will receive their awards and present their essays.
