GLOBAL GATEWAY ALLIANCE STATEMENT ON NEW LAGUARDIA CENTRAL TERMINAL REDEVELOPMENT DELAY

(NEW YORK-NEW JERSEY) – *Below is a statement from Global Gateway Alliance Chairman and Founder Joe Sitt on news of the Port Authority delaying development plans for the LaGuardia Central Terminal Building until the current airport redesign competition is completed:*

“Another day, another airport delay. For months we've been told that there was nothing stopping the selection of a developer to bring LaGuardia's Central Terminal into the 21st Century. Now it's clear that the project is delayed.

“While ensuring coordination between projects is important for the future of the airports, the CTB process has now been going on for more than three years. The CTB is the linchpin in finally improving LaGuardia's reputation and meeting the airport's growth needs, and it's past time for the project to move forward to choosing a developer and starting construction.”
