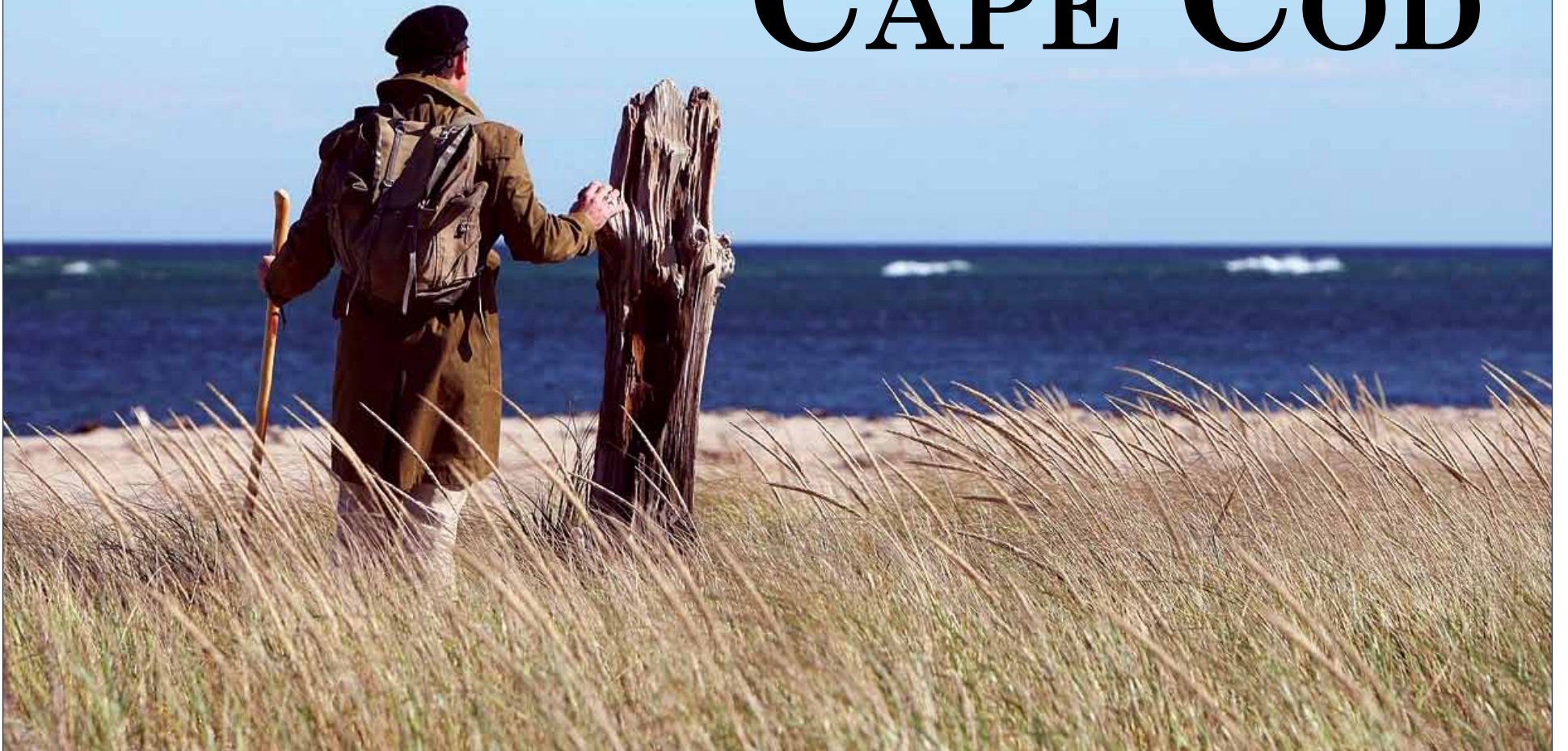

■ **AN INTERNATIONAL STORY:** Before writing his Cape Cod nature classic, Henry Beston survived the horrors of World War I, serving as an ambulance driver for the American Field Service on the front lines of the Battle of Verdun.

■ **A CAPE COD STORY:** Returning home to Massachusetts, he retreated to Cape Cod and wrote the classic book, *The Outermost House* and found the peace of mind he was seeking on the Outer Beach. Years later, *The Outermost House* was cited by the National Park Service as to why the Outer Beach should be preserved.
