

# FRONTLINE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

## (Basic Training)

The Christian life is not made up of an outward set of requirements. It is made up of an obedient servant heart motivated by love for Jesus Christ. At the same time it is acknowledged that it takes a disciplined life to obediently follow after Christ. Therefore, the FSM Scholarship Program is designed to be an encouragement to those teens who are striving to please God by developing Godly disciplines in their lives. Students may commit to the scholarship in September or January. You are strongly encouraged to do the scholarship program for the entire year. The scholarship will be determined based on two different levels.

**LEVEL 1** Spiritual Disciplines (taking in knowledge) This level consists of memorizing scripture weekly, doing a consistent Quiet Time (5 out of 7 days a week), and being regularly involved in FSM Clubs, activities and outreaches. A verse test will be given in January and May over the verses being memorized. Both tests will count toward the scholarship. A 75% or higher will be needed to meet level 1 verse requirements.

**LEVEL 2** Life Applications (giving out to serve) This level consists of applying the Biblical knowledge you are learning to everyday experiences. Examples of this may be: (1) Singing in the Teen Choir (2) Working in Tiny Tots or Children's Church (3) Assisting the leadership of FSM (4) Participating in the church services: providing special music, praying, ushering, greeting, etc. (5) Performing a task to serve someone else (6) Praying for and sharing the gospel with someone. You will need to write on a piece of paper what you did and give it to your small group leader each month. You may only count the same ministry twice during the course of the year or only once if you are only doing the scholarship for 5 months. If you are doing the scholarship from September to January or January to May you will need to do 5 ministries. If you are doing the scholarship for the entire year (Sept to May) you will need a total of 9 ministries.

**SCHOLARSHIPS** are to be applied to a Christian camp, church sponsored missions trip, or Christian college. A full scholarship will be \$300 (September - May). Partial scholarships for participation from September to January only or January to May only will be \$120.00

If you participate in the scholarship program from September to January and do not get a 75% or higher on the verse test and have done the 5 ministries required up to that point you would be encouraged to continue to participate from January to May. If you took the comprehensive verse test at this point and passed it with a 75% or better and met the other requirements you would receive a full \$300.00 scholarship.
