As a child growing up in the Philippines, Chandra witnessed the exploitation of young girls by American soldiers and was herself, a victim of sexual and ritual abuse, in her own home. These memories had been repressed for many years. It was not until after a tragic event of loss that these memories resurfaced and led Chandra on a journey that has helped so many.

After going through the adoption process and accepting two foster children into their home, the Moyers experienced the abusive power of an offended social worker that suddenly had the children removed from their home. The unfathomable loss that this inflicted on Chandra, her husband and their two biological children was just the beginning of the trek that had been set in motion.

Chandra authored *Tragically Taken, Exposing Injustice in the Foster Care System*, an eye opening view into what often happens in America's child welfare system. Intentions may be genuine to help abused children but the system is broken and it is the children who continue to suffer as a result. This book will change the way one views the adoption process in America.

For 13 years, Chandra served as an active and reserve Commissioned U.S. Army Officer achieving the rank of Major. Today, Chandra is the recipient of the 2014 FBI Director's Community Leadership Award and is dedicated to Child Trafficking Prevention on a local, state and national level. She is the President of Release Me International, a non-profit organization that raises awareness about child sex trafficking, connects those who have been trafficked with resources to help restore them, and educates communities in prevention.

She is a motivational speaker with an innate ability to address dreams people have in the night and connect them to their life dreams. She is a certified professional coach and helps individuals by providing a range of strategies to help them achieve their goals and live more fulfilled lives. For years, her speaking engagements have delivered messages of hope that inspire and empower others.

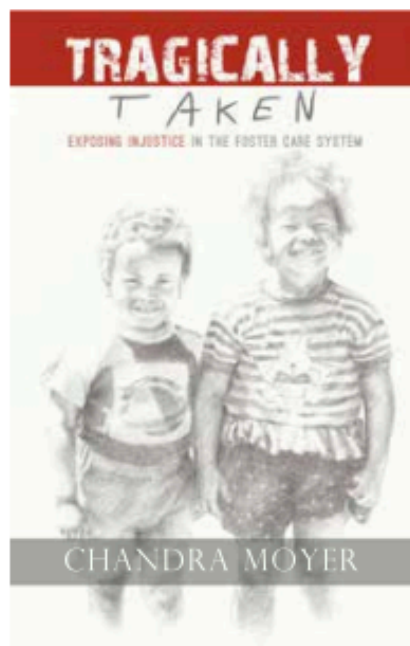
