

- Last Boat Leaves Harborplace for Fort McHenry 3:00pm
- Last Boat Leaves Fell's Point for Fort McHenry 3:15pm
- Last Boat Leaves Fort McHenry 5:00pm
- Plan on visiting Fort McHenry earlier in the day to ensure ample time to visit and avoid longer wait times.
- The National Park Service does not allow us to take originating passengers from the Fort.
 Passengers must have ridden the boat to the Fort in order to re-board there.

Weather Policy

In the event of severe weather (thunder, lightning, severe winds, etc.)...

We will temporarily suspend service of all boats until conditions are deemed safe for transit. Passengers will disembark and taxis will not resume service until the danger has passed. Updates will be posted on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and at 410-563-3900, opt. 1.

One boat will be provided 30 minutes after the final out of the game or 12:30am, whichever comes first. This is for returning fans only and is not our regular service. The return boat leaves only from Landing 2 (Harborplace) and returns to your originating Landing.
