When: July 10-15, 2017

Location: San Francisco, California

Eligibility: Any player who was eligible for the 2017 NFL Draft, or a previous year's

NFL draft, is eligible to participate in The Spring League Showcase.

Format: The Spring League Showcase is a six-day event for professional football

talent. Two teams, comprised primarily of former collegiate and NFL players, will take part in joint practices and receive instruction from professional level coaches. Players will be filmed in both 1 on 1's and

team drill settings.

Game: The Spring League Showcase culminates with a regulation game played in

accordance to NFL rules.

Film Access: Both practice and game film, will be provided to all 32 NFL clubs along

with CFL teams.

Costs: In order to reserve your spot in The Spring League Showcase, you must

register, as either a resident or commuter, and pay the associated

registration fee. Housing and meals will be provided to those players who register under the Resident classification (\$650.00). Those players who register as a Commuter (\$450.00) must arrange for their own housing and

meals.
