FACULTY BIOS

Melody Kay Paul is currently studying at Columbia College Chicago where she intends to graduate in the spring of 2018 with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance and a Bachelor of Arts in Marketing. She has attended DMW and CNADM workshops, multiple summer intensives in NYC and a wide variety of other master classes. She enjoys learning about many disciplines (ballet, tap, modern, hip hop, etc.) and body awareness specifically through injury prevention and physical therapy. Melody has been teaching six plus years and stays invested in her personal education and betterment in order to continue to grow a larger knowledge and resource base. She has been a member of DMW and CNADM (where she serves on the Network Committee) since summer 2014. Melody has completed two levels of the Nan Giordano Certification Program so far and is currently an intern at Giordano Dance Chicago.

Diane Remy is affiliated with and has taught on the faculties of Dance Masters of Wisconsin, Chicago National Association of Dance Masters, Cecchetti Council of America Midwest Branch (where she holds a Grade Five classical ballet teacher rating) and for National Association of Dance and Affiliated Arts. Diane has performed throughout the Midwest, Jacob's Pillow and with the Racine Dance Theater. She received her early training with Helen Finst, Vesper Chamberlin and Tibor Zana. Diane has continued her studies of all dance disciplines with numerous master teachers. Diane's accolades include the Beatrice Scott Award for dance contribution to the J.M. Kohler Arts Center, National Music Person of the Year by the Sheboygan Music Club, election to the Music Wall of Fame in Fountain Park, Sheboygan and in 1999 she received the Wisconsin Dance Council Lifetime Achievement Award. Diane is a 50 year member of DMW and a member of the DMW Hall of Fame.

Suzanne Swanson Wagner is the owner and Artistic Director of Marilyn School of Dance, LLC. Miss Suzanne is well known for her talents as a dancer, teacher, and choreographer. She has studied extensively worldwide in Chicago, Los Angeles, New York, Russia and Paris under Masters in ballet, jazz and tap. Other credits include teaching at the College of St. Theresa in Minnesota, Dance Masters of WI workshops, touring Colorado and abroad to Russia and France with her Vision Dance Company, to Disney World and Carnival Cruise Line with her Dance Stars, choreography for high school and college performance groups, and work with area musical theaters. She is the Artistic Director and Founder of the Monroe-Jackson Dance Theatre for which she has staged The Nutcracker, Thumbelina, Peter Pan, The Sleeping Beauty, Peter and the Wolf and choreographed Alice in Wonderland. Marilyn Wood, for whom the studio is named, was her first teacher and mentor. Suzanne is a member of DMW, and a board member of CNADM. She was inducted into the prestigious DMW Hall of Fame in 2016.

Directions to Brodhead Dance Academy

North/East Directions

From Janesville take WI-11 west for approximately 17 miles. Keep following WI-11 (1st Center Ave) as you enter Brodhead (4-way stop).

From Madison take US-14E. Take the exit for Hwy. 138/Janesville Street; turn Right at the end of the exit ramp. Turn Left on Wolfe Street/Hwy MM (at the lights). Continue straight for approximately 20 miles. Note: Wolf St/Hwy MM becomes Hwy 104 in Brooklyn. Turn Right on WI-11 (1st Center Ave.) as you enter Brodhead (4-way stop).

Entering Brodhead from WI-11 (4-way stop) follow WI-11 west towards downtown. Just before the Piggly Wiggly, turn Right on 16th Street. The Brodhead Dance Academy is next to the post office.

South Directions

From Beloit take WI-81 west for approximately 20 miles. Turn Right on WI-11 E (1st Center Ave.). Turn Left on 16th Street (near Piggly Wiggly). The Brodhead Dance Academy is next to the post office.

Overnight Accommodations:

There are many hotels near Brodhead and a few Bed and Breakfast options in Brodhead. Niteal recommends: Holiday Inn Express Janesville (I-90 & US 14), 3100 Wellington Place and Hampton Inn Janesville, 2400 Fulton Street.
