Before the Olivet discourse

^{KJV} **Matthew 20:17** And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them, ¹⁸ Behold, **we go up to Jerusalem**; and the Son of man shall be **betrayed** unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall **condemn** Him to death, ¹⁹ And shall deliver Him to the Gentiles to **mock**, and to **scourge**, and to **crucify him**: and the **third day He shall rise again**.

The Timing of events are precisely calculated according to the Word of God.

Many have devised other options but we still believe the Bible and four Gospels still Agree!

Prophecy of His death

After speaking with His disciples on the Mount of Olives for 2 days, He announces...

^{KJV} **Matthew 26:1** And it came to pass, when **Jesus had finished all these sayings**, he said unto his disciples, ² **Ye know that after two days is *the feast of the passover***, and the Son of man is **betrayed to be crucified**. ³ Then assembled together the **chief priests**, and the **scribes**, and the **elders** of the people, unto the palace of the **high priest**, who was called **Caiaphas**, ⁴ And consulted that they might **take Jesus by subtilty, and kill him**. ⁵ But they said, **Not on the feast day, lest there be an uproar among the people**. (Mat 26:1 KJV)

But God intended to offer His Passover on the very day that the Passover was to be killed!

The uproar came on that Passover when the multitude cried crucify Him.

^{KJV} **Matthew 27:31** And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify *him*. (Mat 27:31 KJV)

^{KJV} **Mark 15:13** And they cried out again, Crucify him. (Mar 15:13 KJV)

^{KJV} **Mark 15:14** Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, Crucify him. (Mar 15:14 KJV)

^{KJV} **Mark 15:20** And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to crucify him. (Mar 15:20 KJV)

Jesus Christ is the LORD's Passover

Exodus 12

¹ And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt saying,

Exodus 12

² This month [Nissan] shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the **first month [Nissan] of the year to you.**

Exodus 12

³ Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the **tenth [10th] day of this month** they shall **take to them every man a lamb**, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:

⁴ And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.

^{KJV} **1 Corinthians 5:9** I wrote unto you in an epistle not to company with fornicators: ¹⁰ Yet not altogether with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or with idolaters; for then must ye needs go out of the world. ¹¹ But now I have **written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.** ¹² For what have I to do to judge them also that are without? do not ye judge them that are within? ¹³ But them that are without God judgeth. Therefore **put away from among yourselves that wicked person.** (1Co 5:9 KJV)

As Jesus Prophesied

Matthew 27

²⁶ Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had **scourged Jesus**, he **delivered him to be crucified**.

²⁸ And they **stripped him**, and **put on him a scarlet robe**.

²⁹ And when they had **platted a crown of thorns**, they **put it upon his head**, and a **reed in his right hand**: and they **bowed the knee before him**, and **mocked him**, saying, **Hail, King of the Jews!**

Resurrection of the LORD

^{KJG} **Luke 24:1** Now upon the **first day of the week**, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain *others* with them. ² And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre. ³ And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus. ⁴ And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments: ⁵ And as they were afraid, and bowed down *their* faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead? ⁶ He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee, ⁷ Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again. ⁸ And they remembered his words, ⁹ And returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest. (Luk 24:1 KJG)

^{KJV} **Matthew 28:1** In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the **first day of the week**, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre. (Mat 28:1 KJV)

^{KJV} **Mark 16:2** And very early in the morning the **first day of the week**, they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun. (Mar 16:2 KJV)

^{KJV} **Mark 16:9** Now when *Jesus* was risen early the **first day of the week**, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils. (Mar 16:9 KJV)

^{KJV} **John 20:1** The **first day of the week** cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

⁵⁰ Jesus, when He had **cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.**

⁵¹ And, behold, the **veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;**

⁵² And the **graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,**

⁵³ And **came out of the graves after His resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.**

⁵⁴ Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, **Truly this was the Son of God.**

^{KJV} **Matthew 22:23** The same day came to him the **Sadducees**, which say that there is **no resurrection**, and asked him,

After, those who witnessed the events were fearfully changed.

Resurrection Day!

Resurrection unto a glorified body

2 Corinthians 5

¹ For we know that if our **earthly house of this tabernacle** were dissolved, we have a **building of God**, an house **not made with hands, eternal in the heavens**.

² For in this we **groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:**

³ If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

⁴ For we that are in this tabernacle **do groan**, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but **clothed upon**, that **mortality might be swallowed up of life**.

⁵ Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is **God**, who also hath **given unto us the earnest of the Spirit**.

⁶ Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are **at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord:**

⁷ (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

⁸ We are **confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord**.

Resurrection Day!

Resurrection Event

1 Corinthians 15

⁴⁰ There are also **celestial bodies**, and bodies **terrestrial**: but the **glory of the celestial is one**, and the **glory of the terrestrial is another**.

⁴¹ There is one **glory of the sun**, and another glory of the **moon**, and another glory of the **stars**: for **one star differeth from another star in glory**.

⁴² So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in **incorruption**:

⁴³ It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

⁴⁴ It is sown a **natural body**; it is raised a **spiritual body**. There is a **natural body**, and there is a **spiritual body**.

⁴⁵ And so it is written, The **first man Adam** was made a **living soul**; the **last Adam** was made a **quickening spirit**.

⁴⁶ Howbeit that was not **first** which is spiritual, but that which is **natural**; and afterward that which is **spiritual**.

⁴⁷ The **first man is of the earth, earthy**; the **second man is the Lord from heaven**.

⁴⁸ As is the **earthy**, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the **heavenly**, such are they also that are heavenly.

⁴⁹ And as we have **borne the image of the earthy**, we shall also **bear the image of the heavenly**.

⁵⁰ Now this I say, brethren, that **flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God**; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

⁵¹ Behold, I shew you a mystery; **We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed**,

⁵² **In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye**, at the **last trump**: for the **trumpet shall sound**, and the **dead shall be raised incorruptible**, and **we shall be changed**.

⁵³ For this **corruptible must put on incorruption**, and this **mortal must put on immortality**.

⁵⁴ So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and **this mortal shall have put on immortality**, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, **Death is swallowed up in victory**.

⁵⁵ **O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?**

Matthew 16

²⁸ Verily I say unto you, There be **some standing here**, which **shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom**.

Resurrection promised

Ephesians 1

¹³ In whom ye also **trusted**, after that ye **heard the word of truth**, the gospel of **your salvation**: in whom also after that ye **believed**, ye were **sealed** with that holy **Spirit of promise**,

¹⁴ Which is the **earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession**, unto the **praise of His glory**.

Two Resurrections

John 5

²⁹ And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the **resurrection of life**; and they that have done evil, unto the **resurrection of damnation**

Holy Resurrected

Revelation 20

⁶ **Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection**: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Unholy Resurrected

Revelation 20

¹³ And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and **hell delivered up the dead which were in them**: and they were judged every man according to their works.

¹⁴ And **death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.**

John 6

⁵³ Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.**

⁵⁴ **Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.**

⁵⁵ For my **flesh is meat** indeed, and my **blood is drink** indeed.

John 11

²⁴ Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.

²⁵ Jesus said unto her, **I am the resurrection, and the life:** he that believeth in me, **though he were dead, yet shall he live:**

²⁶ And whosoever **liveth and believeth in me shall never die.** Believest thou this?

⁴ And **declared to be the Son of God** with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the **resurrection from the dead:**

¹⁹ If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.

1 Peter 1

Resurrection for all the Righteous on the Last day

John 6

³⁸ For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

³⁹ And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

⁴⁰ And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and **I will raise him up at the last day.**

Saints Resurrected like Him

Romans 6

³ Know ye not, that so many of us as were **baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?**

⁴ Therefore we are **buried with Him by baptism into death:** that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so **we also should walk in newness of life.**

⁵ For if we have been **planted together in the likeness of His death, we shall be also in the likeness of His resurrection:**

1 Thessalonians 4:

¹⁶ For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the **dead in Christ shall rise first:**

¹⁷ Then **we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.**

¹⁸ Wherefore **comfort one another with these words.**

1 John 3

² Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and **it doth not yet appear what we shall be:** but we know that, **when he shall appear [on the LAST DAY], we [all the saints] shall be like Him;** for we shall see Him as He is.
