Genesis 1 WHO...WHAT ...WHEN!

6 And **God** said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.

God – OT:430 > אֱלֹהִים > 'elohiym (el-o-heem'); plural of OT:433; gods in the ordinary sense; but specifically used (in the plural thus, especially with the article) of the supreme God; occasionally applied by way of deference to magistrates; and sometimes as a superlative: KJV - angels, exceeding, God (gods)- dess, -ly), (very) great, judges, mighty.

...from the plural of OT:433 > אֱלֹהִים > 'elowahh (el-o'-ah; rarely (shortened) 'eloahh (el-o'-ah); probably prolonged (emphat.) from OT:410; a deity or the Deity: KJV - God, god. See OT:430.

Let there be – OT:1961 > הָיָה > hayah (haw-yaw); a primitive root [compare OT:1933]; to exist, i.e. be or become, come to pass (always emphatic, and not a mere copula or auxiliary): KJV - beacon, altogether, be (-come), accomplished, committed, like), break, cause, come (to pass), do, faint, fall, follow, happen, have, last, pertain, quit (oneself-), require, use.

Isaiah 45

12 I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the **heavens**, and all **their host have I commanded**.

Firmament – OT:7549 > רָקִיעַ > raqiya` (raw-kee'-ah); from OT:7554; properly, an expanse, i.e. the firmament or (apparently) visible arch of the sky: KJV - firmament.

...from – OT:7554 > רָקַע > raqa` (raw-kah'); a primitive root; to pound the earth (as a sign of passion); by analogy to expand (by hammering); by implication, to overlay (with thin sheets of metal):

KJV - beat, make broad, spread abroad (forth, over, out, into plates), stamp, stretch.

Midst – OT:8432 > תָּוֶק > tavek (tav'-vek); from an unused root meaning to sever; a bisection, i.e. (by implication) the centre:

KJV - among (-st), between, half, (therewhere-), in (-to), middle, mid [-night], midst (among), out (of), through, with (-in).

Divide – OT:914 > בָּדַל > badal (baw-dal'); a primitive root; to divide (in variation senses literally or figuratively, separate, distinguish, differ, select, etc.):

KJV - (make, put) difference, divide (asunder), (make) separate (self, -ation), sever (out), utterly.

Acts 13

47 For so hath the **Lord commanded** us, saying, I have set thee to be a **light of the Gentiles**, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth.

Proverbs 8

14 Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength.

15 By me kings reign, and princes decree justice.

16 By me princes rule, and nobles, even all the judges of the earth.

17 I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.

18 Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness.

19 My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver.

29 When he **gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth:**

30 Then I was by him, as one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight, rejoicing always before him;

31 Rejoicing in the habitable part of his earth; and my delights were with the sons of men.

32 Now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children: for blessed are they that keep my ways.

33 Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not.

34 Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.

35 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD.

36 But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death.

Isaiah 40 ...One Canvas

21 Have ye not known? have ye not heard? hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not understood from the foundations of the earth?

22 It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that **stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain**, and **spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in**:

23 That bringeth the princes to nothing; he maketh the judges of the earth as vanity.

Isaiah 45 ...One Artist

18 For thus saith **the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth** and made it; he hath established it, he **created it not in vain**, he **formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD**; and **there is none else**.

Isaiah 43

15 I am the LORD, your Holy One, the **creator** of Israel, your King.

Deuteronomy 33 ...One so Excellent

26 There is none like unto the God of Jeshurun, who rideth upon the heaven in thy help, and in his excellency on the **sky**.

1 Kings 8 ...One Omnipotent

26 And now, O God of Israel, let thy word, I pray thee, be verified, which thou spakest unto thy servant David my father.

27 But will God indeed dwell on the earth? behold, **the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain thee**; how much less this house that I have builded?

2 Corinthians 4 ...One Face

6 For God, who **commanded the light to shine out of darkness**, hath **shined in our hearts**, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

7 But **we have this treasure in earthen vessels**, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

The heavens are as the manifestation of the countenance of the face of God Himself!

Psalms 19 ...One firmament

1 The heavens **declare the glory of God**; and the **firmament** sheweth his handywork.

Psalms 150 ...One Sanctuary

1 Praise ye the LORD. Praise God **in his sanctuary**: **praise** him in the firmament of his **power**.

Psalm 89 ...One Founder (this is where the world will flounder)

11 The heavens are thine, the earth also is thine: as for the world and the fulness thereof, thou hast **founded them**.

Isaiah 51

15 But I am the LORD thy God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The LORD of hosts is his name.

16 And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have **covered thee in the shadow of mine hand**, that I may **plant the heavens**, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou art my people.

17 Awake, awake, stand up, O Jerusalem, which hast drunk at the hand of the LORD the cup of his fury; thou hast drunken the dregs of the cup of trembling, and wrung them out.

God – OT:430 ><אֱלֹהִים > 'elohiym (el-o-heem'); plural of OT:433; gods in the ordinary sense; but specifically used (in the plural thus, especially with the article) of the supreme God; occasionally applied by way of deference to magistrates; and sometimes as a superlative: KJV - angels, exceeding, God (gods)- dess, -ly), (very) great, judges, mighty.

...from the plural of OT:433 >אֱלֹהִים > 'elowahh (el-o'-ah; rarely (shortened) 'eloahh (el-o'-ah); probably prolonged (emphat.) from OT:410; a deity or the Deity: KJV - God, god. See OT:430.

Made – OT:6213 >עָשָׂה > `asah (aw-saw'); a primitive root; to do or make, in the broadest sense and widest application (as follows):

KJV - accomplish, advance, appoint, apt, be at, become, bear, bestow, bring forth, bruise, be busy, certainly, have the charge of, commit, deal (with), deck, displease, do, (ready) dress (-ed), (put in) execute (-ion), exercise, fashion, feast, [fighting-] man, finish, fit, fly, follow, fulfill, furnish, gather, get, go about, govern, grant, great, hinder, hold ([a feast]), indeed, be industrious, journey, keep, labour, maintain, make, be meet, observe, be occupied, offer, officer, pare, bring (come) to pass, perform, precise, prepare, procure, provide, put, requite, sacrifice, serve, set, shew, sin, spend, surely, take, thoroughly, trim, very, vex, be [warr-] ior, work (-man), yield, use.

Under – OT:8478 >תַּחַת > tachath (takh'-ath); from the same as OT:8430; the bottom (as depressed); only adverbially, below (often with prepositional prefix underneath), in lieu of, etc.: KJV - as, beneath, flat, in (-stead), (same) place (where ... is), room, for ... sake, stead of, under, unto, when ... was mine, whereas, [wherefore-], with.

Above – OT:5921 >עַל > `al (al); properly, the same as OT:5920 used as a preposition (in the singular or plural often with prefix, or as conjunction with a particle following); above, over, upon, or against (yet always in this last relation with a downward aspect) in a great variety of applications (as follow):

KJV - above, according to (-ly), after, (as) against, among, and, as, at, because of, beside (the rest of), between, beyond the time, both and, by (reason of), had the charge of, concerning for, in (that), (forth, out) of, (from) (off), (up-) on, over, than, through (-out), to, touching, with.

...from – OT:5920 >עַל > `al (al); from OT:5927; properly, the top; specifically, the highest (i.e. God); also (adverb) aloft, to Jehovah: KJV - above, high, Most High.

Firmament – OT:7554 >רָקַע > raqa` (raw-kah'); a primitive root; to pound the earth (as a sign of passion); by analogy to expand (by hammering); by implication, to overlay (with thin sheets of metal):

KJV - beat, make broad, spread abroad (forth, over, out, into plates), stamp, stretch.

it was – OT:1961 >הָיָה > hayah (haw-yaw); a primitive root [compare OT:1933]; to exist, i.e. be or become, come to pass (always emphatic, and not a mere copula or auxiliary):

KJV - beacon, altogether, be (-come), accomplished, committed, like), break, cause, come (to pass), do, faint, fall, follow, happen, have, last, pertain, quit (oneself-), require, use.

So – OT:3651 >כֵּן > ken (kane); from OT:3559; properly, set upright; hence (figuratively as adjective) just; but usually (as adverb or conjunction) rightly or so (in various applications to manner, time and relation; often with other particles):

KJV - after that (this, -ward, -wards), as ... as, [for-] asmuch as yet, be (for which) cause, following, howbeit, in (the) like (manner, -wise), the more, right, (even) so, state, straightway, such (thing), surely, there (wherefore)-, this, thus, true, well, you.

Genesis 1 HOW! (Cont)

7 And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so.

God Made it

1 Chronicles 16

26 For all the gods of the people are idols: but **the LORD made the heavens.**

Isaiah 45

12 I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, **even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded.**

Jeremiah 10 ...by skillfulness

12 He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath **stretched out the heavens by his discretion.**

Discretion – OT:8394 > תְּבוּנָה > tabuwn (taw-boon'); and (feminine) tebuwnah (teb-oo-naw'); or towbunah (to-boo-naw'); from OT:995; intelligence; by implication, an argument; by extension, caprice:

KJV - discretion, reason, skillfulness, understanding, wisdom.

Jeremiah 10 ...out of His Treasuries (treasures)

13 When he **uttereth his voice**, there is a **multitude of waters in the heavens**, and he **causeth the vapours to ascend** from the ends of the earth; he maketh lightnings with rain, and **bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures.**

Psalm 8 ...with the fingers of HIS HAND

3 When I **consider thy heavens**, the **work of thy fingers**, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained;

Nehemiah 9 ...for the host of the heavens

6 Thou, even thou, art LORD alone; thou hast made heaven, the heaven of **heavens**, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein, the seas, and all that is therein, and thou preservest them all; and the host of heaven worshippeth thee.

Job 9

7 Which commandeth the sun, and it riseth not; and seaeth up the stars.

8 Which alone **spreadeth out the heavens**, and **treadeth upon the waves of the sea.** [*moved upon the face of the deep*]

9 Which maketh Arcturus, Orion, and Pleiades, and the chambers of the south.

By the word of the Lord

Psalm 33

5 He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.

6 By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them **by the breath of his mouth.**

7 He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the depth in storehouses.

By the Right Hand of God

Isaiah 48

13 Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and my **right hand hath spanned the heavens**: when I call unto them, they stand up together.

As it was in the beginning

Psalm 74

12 For God is my King of old, working salvation in the midst of the earth.

13 Thou didst divide the sea by thy strength: thou brakest the heads of the dragons in the waters.

Psalm 78

13 He **divided** the sea, and caused them to pass through; and he made the **waters** to stand as an heap.

Nehemiah 9

11 And thou didst **divide** the sea before them, so that they went through the midst of the sea on the dry land; and their persecutors thou threwest into the deeps, as a stone into the mighty waters.

Glorious Creation – Day 2

Genesis 1 WHY!

8 And God called [pronounced, announced] the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day.

Heaven – OT:8064 > שָׁמַיִם > shamayim (shaw-mah'-yim); dual of an unused singular shameh (shaw-meh'); from an unused root meaning to be lofty; the sky (as aloft; the dual perhaps alluding to the visible arch in which the clouds move, as well as to the higher ether where the celestial bodies revolve): KJV - air, astrologer, heaven (-s).

Evening – OT:6153 > עֶרֶב > `ereb (eh'-reb); from OT:6150; dusk:
KJV - day, even (-ing, tide), night.

...from – OT:6150EW > עָרַב > `arab (aw-rab'); a primitive root [identical with OT:6148 through the idea of covering with a texture]; to grow dusky at sundown:
KJV - be darkened, (toward) evening.

Morning – OT:1242 > בֹּקֶר > boqer (bo'-ker); from OT:1239; properly, dawn (as the break of day); generally, morning: KJV - (+)day, early, morning, morrow.

...from – OT:1239 > בָּקַר > baqar (baw-kar); a primitive root; properly, to plough, or (generally) break forth, i.e. (figuratively) to inspect, admire, care for, consider:
KJV - (make) inquire (-ry), (make) search, seek out.

Deuteronomy 10 ...speaking of all the heavens

14 Behold, the **heaven and the heaven of heavens** is the LORD's thy God, the earth also, with all that therein is.

Isaiah 50

3 I clothe the **heavens** with blackness, and I make sackcloth their covering.

Firmament above

Genesis 1 ...for light

14 And God said, Let there be lights in the **firmament** of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years:

15 And let them be **for lights** in the **firmament** of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so.

17 And God set them in the **firmament** of the heaven to give light upon the earth,

Firmament below

Genesis 1 ...for transportation

20 And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open **firmament** of heaven

For Communication

Daniel 12 ...illumination

1 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.

2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

3 And they that be wise shall shine as the **brightness of the firmament**; and they that turn many to **righteousness as the stars** for ever and ever.

Deuteronomy 32 ...amplification

1 **Give ear, O ye heavens**, and I will speak; and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.

2 My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass:

3 Because I will publish the name of the LORD: ascribe ye greatness unto our God.

Psalm 19

HIS Revelation To Reveal Himself to His Creation! To reveal His Glory

Psalm 8

1 O LORD, our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! who hast **set thy glory above the heavens.**

To reveal His predetermine will

Psalm 8

2 Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest still the enemy and the avenger.

3 When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, **which thou hast ordained;**

To reveal His Judgment

Psalm 50 ...used to communicate

3 Our God shall come, and shall not keep silence: a **fire shall devour before him**, and it shall be very tempestuous round about him.

Psalm 50 ...used to judge

4 He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, **that he may judge his people.**

Psalm 50 ...used to gather saints

5 Gather my **saints together unto me**; those that have made a covenant with me **by sacrifice.**

Psalm 73 ...and leave behind the wicked

8 They are corrupt, and speak wickedly concerning oppression: they speak loftily.

9 **They set their mouth against the heavens**, and their tongue walketh through the earth. *{to the face of God}*

To reveal His Righteousness

Psalm 50

6 And the **heavens shall declare his righteousness**: for God is judge himself. Selah.

Isaiah 42

4 He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till he have set judgment in the earth: and the isles shall wait for his law.

5 Thus saith **God the LORD**, he that **created the heavens**, and **stretched them out**; he that **spread forth the earth**, and that which cometh out of it; he that **giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein:**

6 I the LORD have **called thee in righteousness**, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a **light of the Gentiles;**

6 Thy righteousness is like the great mountains; thy judgments are a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.

Psalm 89

2 For I have said, **Mercy shall be built up for ever:** thy faithfulness shalt thou establish in the very heavens.

Psalm 57

10 **For thy mercy is great unto the heavens,** and thy truth unto the clouds.

Psalm 57

To reveal His Faithfulness

Psalm 36

5 Thy mercy, O LORD, is in the heavens; and thy **faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds.**

6 Thy righteousness is like the great mountains; thy **judgments are a great deep:** O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.

Psalm 89

2 For I have said, Mercy shall be built up for ever: **thy faithfulness shalt thou establish in the very heavens.**

Psalm 89

5 And the heavens shall praise thy wonders, O LORD: thy **faithfulness also** in the congregation of the saints.

Genesis 1 WHY! (Cont)

8 And God called [pronounced, announced] the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day.

To manifest Himself (invisible)

Psalm 68 ...in the heavens

4 Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: extol him that **rideth upon the heavens** by his name JAH, and rejoice before him.

Psalm 68 ...in the heaven of heavens

32 Sing unto God, ye kingdoms of the earth; O sing praises unto the Lord; Selah:

33 To him that **rideth upon the heavens of heavens**, which were of old; lo, he doth send out his voice, and that a mighty voice.

34 Ascribe ye strength unto God: his excellency is over Israel, and his strength is in the clouds.

To congregate the Praise of His Wonders

Psalm 89

5 And **the heavens shall praise thy wonders, O LORD**: thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints.

To Reveal the Wisdom of God

Proverbs 8Wisdom speaks

26 While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world.

27 **When he prepared the heavens, I was there**: when he set a compass upon the face of the depth:

Compass – OT:2329 >חוג > chuwg (khoog); from OT:2328; a circle:

KJV - circle, circuit, compass.

...from – OT:2328 >חוג > chuwg (khoog); a primitive root [compare OT:2287]; to describe a circle: KJV - compass.

Reveals the wisdom of God to prepare a firmament that could hold so great a weight as the waters

To Reveal his Strength

28 When he **established the clouds above**: when he **strengthened the fountains** of the deep:

For His purpose

Isaiah 51

6 Lift up your eyes to the **heavens**, and look upon the earth beneath: for the **heavens** shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my salvation shall be for ever, and my righteousness shall not be abolished.

As a window

Ezekiel 1

1 Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth month, in the fifth day of the month, as I was among the captives by the river of Chebar, that the **heavens** were opened, and I saw visions of God.

Matthew 3

15 And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him.

16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Acts 2

33 Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

34 For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, **The Lord said unto my Lord**, Sit thou on my right hand,

35 Until I make thy foes thy footstool.

Acts 7 ...The sermon of Stephen

55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.

57 Then they cried out with a loud voice, and stopped their ears, and ran upon him with one accord,
