One Baptism

Into Jesus Christ

Romans 6

³ Know ye not, that so many of us as were **baptized into Jesus Christ** were **baptized into his death?**

Baptized – [NT:907](#) βαπτίζω **baptizo** (bap-tid'-zo); from a derivative of [NT:911](#); to immerse, submerge; to make overwhelmed (i.e. fully wet); used only (in the N. T.) of ceremonial ablution, especially (technically) of the ordinance of Christian baptism: **KJV** - Baptist, baptize, wash.

Acts 8 ...not without The Holy Ghost

¹⁵ Who, when they were come down, **prayed** for them, that **they might receive the Holy Ghost:**

¹⁶ (For as yet **he was fallen upon none** of them: only they were **baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.**)

¹⁷ Then **laid they their hands on them**, and they **received the Holy Ghost.**

Luke 12 ...Divisive

⁵⁰ But I have a baptism to be **baptized** with; and how am I straitened till it be accomplished!

Into His Death

Romans 6

A quickened sacrifice

Matthew 3 ...Mighty baptism in trials

¹¹ I indeed **baptize you with water unto repentance.** but he that cometh after me is **mightier** than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall **baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:**

Matthew 20

²¹ And he said unto her, What wilt thou? She saith unto him, Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on thy right hand, and the other on the left, in thy kingdom.

²² But Jesus answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. **Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?** They say unto him, **We are able.**

Baptized – [NT:908](#) βάπτισμα **baptisma** (bap'-tis-mah); from [NT:907](#); immersion, baptism (technically or figuratively): **KJV** - baptism.

²³ And he saith unto them, **Ye shall drink indeed of my cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with:** but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of my Father.

1 Corinthians 15 ...daily sacrifice

³¹ I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, **I die daily.**

Acts 26 ...to show light

²³ That **Christ should suffer**, and that he should be the **first** that should **rise from the dead**, and should **shew light** unto the people, and to the Gentiles.

Romans 8 ...glory is great than suffering

¹⁸ For I reckon that the **sufferings of this present time** are **not worthy** to be compared with the **glory** which shall be revealed in us.

2 Corinthians 1 ...suffering and comforting

⁴ Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.

⁵ For as the **sufferings of Christ abound in us**, so our **consolation also aboundeth by Christ.**

⁶ And whether we be **afflicted**, it is **for your consolation and salvation**, which is **effectual in the enduring** of the same sufferings which we also suffer: **or whether we be comforted**, it is **for your consolation and salvation.**

Philippians 1

²⁹ For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake;

Philippians 1

¹² But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the **things which happened** unto me have **fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel;**

One Death

Hebrews 9

²⁷ And as **it is appointed unto men once to die**, but after this the judgment:

Romans 6

⁹ Knowing that **Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.**

Dominion – [NT:2961](#) κυριεύω **kurieuo** (ko-ree-yoo'-o); from [NT:2962](#); to rule:
KJV - have dominion over, lord, be lord of, exercise lordship over.

Romans 6

¹⁰ For in that **he died, he died unto sin once**: but in that **he liveth, he liveth unto God.**

One Spirit

By His Holy Spirit

Romans 6

⁴ Therefore we are **buried with Him by baptism into death**: that like as **Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father**, even so we also should **walk in newness of life.**

Mark 1

⁸ I [John] indeed have baptized you with water: but **He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.**

1 Corinthians 12

¹³ For **by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body**, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been **all made to drink into one Spirit.**

Acts 1

⁵ For **John truly baptized with water**; but ye shall **be baptized with the Holy Ghost** not many days hence.

Acts 9

¹⁷ And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, **Brother Saul**, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be **filled with the Holy Ghost.**

¹⁸ And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was **baptized.**

Acts 11

¹⁵ And as I began to speak, **the Holy Ghost fell on them, as on us at the beginning.**

¹⁶ Then **remembered I the word of the Lord**, how that he said, **John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost.**

Acts 19

³ And he said unto them, Unto **what then were ye baptized?** And they said, Unto **John's baptism.**

⁴ Then said Paul, John verily **baptized with the baptism of repentance**, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.

⁵ When they heard this, they were **baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.**

By that One we have access unto our Father

Ephesians 2

¹⁸ For through him we both have **access by one Spirit unto the Father.**

By that One we have Hope

Ephesians 4

⁴ There is one body, and **one Spirit**, even as ye are called in **one hope of your calling;**

Hebrews 11

¹ Now **faith** is the **substance of things hoped for**, the evidence of things not seen.

By that One we have Faith

Philippians 1

²⁷ Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye **stand fast in one spirit, with one mind** striving together for the [one] faith of the gospel;

One Time Forgiven Under Grace

Ephesians 1

⁷ In whom we have **redemption** through his blood, the **forgiveness** of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Romans 6 ...Where sin abounded, grace did much more abound...

¹ What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?

Romans 6

² God forbid. How shall we, that are **dead to sin**, live any longer therein?

Mark 16

¹⁶ **He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.**

Acts 2

³⁸ Then Peter said unto them, **Repent, and be baptized** every one of you in the **name of Jesus Christ** for the **remission of sins**, and ye shall **receive the gift of the Holy Ghost**.

Remission – [NT:859](#) ἄφεσις **aphesis** (af'-es-is); from [NT:863](#); freedom; (figuratively) pardon: **KJV** - deliverance, forgiveness, liberty, remission.

...from – [NT:863](#) ἀφίημι **aphiemi** (af-ee'-ay-mee); from [NT:575](#) and hiemi (to send; an intens. form of eimi, to go); to send forth, in various applications (as follow):

KJV - cry, forgive, forsake, lay aside, leave, let (alone, be, go, have), omit, put (send) away, remit, suffer, yield up.

*Without the remission of sins then death would still reign over us...
...and I assure you that the survival rate is nil... 0% survive!*

Put of the Old Man

Romans 6

⁶ Knowing this, that our **old man is crucified with him**, that the **body of sin might be destroyed**, that henceforth **we should not serve sin**.

Sin is no longer our master!

Free forever from Sin

Romans 6

⁷ For **he that is dead is freed from sin**.

Bible Minded for Romans **Walk in Newness of Life**

No longer in bondage to Sin

Romans 6

¹⁴ For **sin shall not have dominion over you**: for ye are **not under the law**, but **under grace**.

No authority license to sin

Romans 6 ...free NOT to sin!

¹⁵ What then? **shall we sin**, because we are **not under the law**, but under **grace**? **God forbid**.

We reveal the master to whom we are servants

Romans 6

¹⁶ Know ye not, that to whom ye **yield yourselves servants to obey**, **his servants ye are** to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of **obedience unto righteousness**?

Servants to Righteous Master and holy...

Romans 6

¹⁹ I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so **now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness**.

Sin no longer Reigns

Romans 6

¹² **Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body**, that ye should obey it in the **lusts thereof**.

Romans 6

¹⁸ Being then **made free from sin**, ye became the **servants of righteousness**.

He died that He should reign in our hearts, our minds, our lives

New Spirit

Romans 7

⁶ But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we **should serve in newness of spirit**, and not in the oldness of the letter.

One Deliverer

Romans 6

¹¹ Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be **dead indeed unto sin**, but **alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord**.

Hebrews 10

¹⁶ This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, **I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them**;

¹⁷ And their **sins and iniquities will I remember no more**.

¹⁸ Now **where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin**.

One Resurrection unto Life

Romans 1 ...by resurrection I declare Him all powerful Mighty God and Everlasting Father
⁴ And **declared to be the Son of God with power**, according to the spirit of holiness, **by the resurrection from the dead:**

Planted in His death

Romans 6

⁵ For if we have been **planted together in the likeness of his death**, we shall be **also in the likeness of his resurrection:**

Romans 6

⁸ Now **if we be dead with Christ**, we believe that we shall also live with Him:

Galatians 3

²⁷ For as many of you as have been **baptized into Christ have put on Christ.**

Philippians 3

⁹ And be **found in him**, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is **through the faith** of Christ, the **righteousness which is of God by faith:**

¹⁰ That I may **know him**, and the **power of his resurrection**, and the **fellowship of his sufferings**, being **made conformable unto his death;**

¹¹ **If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.**

Yield unto your Life Giver

Romans 6

¹³ Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but **yield yourselves unto God**, as those that are **alive from the dead**, and your members as instruments of righteousness **unto God.**

Romans 6

²³ For **the wages of sin is death**; but **the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.**

1 Peter 1

³ Blessed be the **God and Father** of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath **begotten us again** unto a **lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ** from the dead,

One LORD

Thankfulness is seen in obedience to One Master

Romans 6

¹⁷ But **God be thanked**, that ye **were** the servants of sin, but ye **have obeyed from the heart** that form of doctrine which was **delivered you**.

Matthew 6

²⁴ **No man can serve two masters**: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. **Ye cannot serve God and mammon**.

Romans 6

²² But **now being made free from sin**, and become **servants to God**, ye have your **fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life**.

Zechariah 14

⁹ And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one.

Mark 12

²⁹ And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

One Father

1 Corinthians 8

⁶ But **to us** there is but **one God**, the **Father**, of whom **are all things**, and **we in him**; and **one Lord Jesus Christ**, by whom **are all things**, and **we by him**.

Ephesians 4

⁶ **One God and Father of all**, who is **above all**, and **through all**, and **in you all**.

New Love

John 13

³⁴ A **new commandment** I give unto you, That ye **love one another**; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

New Creature

Galatians 6

¹⁴ But God forbid that I should **glory**, save in **the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ**, by whom **the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world**.

¹⁵ For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but **a new creature**.

¹⁶ And as many as **walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy**, and upon the Israel of God.

2 Corinthians 5

¹⁷ Therefore if any man be in Christ, **he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new**.

New Mind

Ephesians 4

²³ And be **renewed in the spirit of your mind;**

²⁴ And that ye **put on the new man**, which after God is **created in righteousness and true holiness**.

²⁵ Wherefore **putting away lying, speak every man truth** with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.

New Way of Thinking

Colossians 3

⁹ **Lie not one to another**, seeing that ye have **put off the old man with his deeds;**

¹⁰ And have **put on the new man**, which is **renewed in knowledge** after the image of him that created him:

¹¹ Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all.

2 Corinthians 6

¹⁶ And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as **God hath said**, I will **dwell in them**, and **walk in them**; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Battling victoriously

2 Corinthians 10

² But I beseech you, that I may not be bold when I am present with that confidence, wherewith I think to be bold against some, which think of us as if we walked according to the flesh.

³ For **though we walk in the flesh**, we **do not war after the flesh**:

In purity

Galatians 5

¹⁶ This I say then, **Walk in the Spirit**, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

¹⁷ For **the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh**: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

In holy behavior

Galatians 5

²⁴ And they that are Christ's have **crucified the flesh** with the affections and lusts.

²⁵ If we live in the Spirit, let us also **walk in the Spirit**.

²⁶ Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

In faithful works in accordance to the Word of God.

Ephesians 2

⁸ For **by grace are ye saved through faith**; and that **not of yourselves**: it is the **gift of God**:

⁹ **Not of works**, lest any man should boast.

¹⁰ For **we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works**, which God hath before ordained that we should **walk in them**.

In knowledge and understanding and wisdom

Ephesians 4

¹⁷ This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth **walk not as other**

Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,

¹⁸ Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

¹⁹ Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.

²⁰ But ye have not so learned Christ;

In wisdom

Colossians 4

⁵ **Walk in wisdom** toward them that are without, redeeming the time.

In love

Ephesians 5

¹ Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children;

² And **walk in love**, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

³ But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints;

⁴ Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather **giving of thanks**.

⁵ For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

⁶ Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.

⁷ **Be not ye therefore partakers with them.**

⁸ For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are **ye light in the Lord: walk as children** of light:

2 John 1

⁶ And **this is love**, that we **walk after his commandments**. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should **walk in it**..

Psalm 119

⁴⁴ So shall I **keep thy law continually** for ever and ever.

⁴⁵ And I will **walk at liberty**: for I **seek thy precepts**.

⁴⁶ I will **speak of thy testimonies** also before kings, and **will not be ashamed**.

1 John 1

⁷ But if we **walk in the light**, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

In Peace

Ephesians 4

¹ I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye **walk worthy of the vocation** wherewith ye are called,

² With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;

³ Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

In sincerity

Colossians 1

⁹ For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

¹⁰ That ye might **walk worthy of the Lord** unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

¹¹ Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

Faithfully

1 Thessalonians 2

¹¹ As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father doth his children,

¹² That ye would **walk worthy of God**, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.

¹³ For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye **received it not as the word of men**, but as **it is in truth**, the word of God, which **effectually worketh also in you that believe**.

In Truth

3 John 1 ...joyfully

⁴ I have no greater joy than to hear that my children **walk in truth**.
