# **A Priestly Lamb**

### **Hebrews 9**

<sup>11</sup> But Christ <u>being come</u> an high priest of good things to come, by a <u>greater</u> and more <u>perfect tabernacle</u>, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this <u>building</u>;

Being come – NT:3854 παραγίνομαι **paraginomai** (par-ag-in'-om-ahee); from NT:3844 and NT:1096; to become near, i.e. approach (have arrived); by implication, to appear publicly:  $\textbf{\textit{KJV}}$  - come, go, be present.

<u>Greater</u> – <u>NT:3187</u> μείζων **meizon** (mide'-zone); irregular comparative of <u>NT:3173</u>; larger (literally or figuratively, specifically in age):

KJV - elder, greater (-est), more.

Perfect – NT:5046 Τέλειος **teleios** (tel'-i-os); from NT:5056; complete (in various applications of labor, growth, mental and moral character, etc.); neuter (as noun, with NT:3588) completeness:

KJV - of full age, man, perfect.

Tabernacle – NT:4633 σκηνή **skene** (skay-nay'); apparently akin to NT:4632 and NT:4639; a tent or cloth hut (literally or figuratively):

**KJV** - habitation, tabernacle.

Building – NT:2937 ΚΤίσις **ktisis** (ktis'-is); from NT:2936; original formation (properly, the act; by implication, the thing, literally or figuratively):  $\textbf{\textit{KJV}}$  - building, creation, creature, ordinance.

### John 1

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the **Lamb of God**, which **taketh away the sin** of the world.

#### John 1

<sup>36</sup> And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the **Lamb of God!** 

#### **Hebrews 3**

<sup>1</sup>Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider **the Apostle** and **High Priest of our profession**, **Christ Jesus**;

- <sup>2</sup>Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house.
- <sup>3</sup> For this man was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath **builded the house** hath more honour than the house.

### **Revelation 5**

<sup>6</sup> And I beheld, and, lo, **in the midst of the throne** and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb** as it **had been slain**, having **seven horns and seven eyes**, which are the **seven Spirits of God** sent forth into all the earth.

# Revelation 6 the wicked will acknowledge Him

<sup>23</sup> And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the **glory of God did lighten it**, and **the Lamb is the light** thereof.

Once – NT:2178 ἐφάπαξ **ephapax** (ef-ap'-ax); from NT:1909 and NT:530; upon one occasion (only):  $\textbf{\textit{KJV}}$  - (at) once (for all).

Redemption – NT:3085 λύτρωσις **lutrosis** (loo'-tro-sis); from NT:3084; a ransoming (figuratively): **KJV** - + redeemed, redemption.

#### **Hebrews 7**

<sup>25</sup> Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

<sup>26</sup> For such an **high priest became us**, who is **holy**, **harmless**, **undefiled**, **separate** from sinners, and **made higher than the heavens**;

Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself.

Once – NT:2178 ἐφάπαξ **ephapax** (ef-ap'-ax); from NT:1909 and NT:530; upon one occasion (only):  $\textbf{\textit{KJV}}$  - (at) once (for all).

## **A Pure Lamb**

#### **Hebrews 9**

<sup>13</sup> For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer <u>sprinkling</u> the unclean, <u>sanctifieth</u> to the <u>purifying</u> of the flesh:

Sanctifieth – NT:37  $\dot{\alpha}$ γι $\dot{\alpha}$ ζω **hagiazo** (hag-ee-ad'-zo); from NT:40; to make holy, i.e. (ceremonially) purify or consecrate; (mentally) to venerate: **KJV** - hallow, be holy, sanctify.

Sprinkling – NT:4472 ραντίζω **rhantizo** (hran-tid'-zo); from a derivative of rhaino (to sprinkle); to render besprinkled, i.e. asperse (ceremonially or figuratively):  $\textbf{\textit{KJV}}$  - sprinkle.

<u>Purifying</u> – <u>NT:2514</u> καθαρότης **katharotes** (kath-ar-ot'-ace); from <u>NT:2513</u>; cleanness (cer.): **KJV** - purification.

### **Hebrews 8**

<sup>1</sup>Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;

<sup>2</sup> A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man.

<sup>3</sup>For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this man have somewhat also to offer.

### Matthew 5

<sup>8</sup> Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

## 1 Timothy 5

<sup>22</sup> Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins: **keep** thyself pure.

## 2 Timothy 2

<sup>22</sup> Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that **call on the Lord out of a pure heart.** 

#### James 1

<sup>27</sup> **Pure** religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

### **Proverbs 30**

<sup>5</sup> Every word of God is **pure**: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him.

## Hebrews 9 (cont)

<sup>13</sup> For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer <u>sprinkling</u> the unclean, <u>sanctifieth</u> to the <u>purifying</u> of the flesh:

### Leviticus 20

<sup>7</sup> Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the LORD your God.

### John 17

<sup>19</sup> And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

### Joshua 3

<sup>5</sup> And Joshua said unto the people, **Sanctify yourselves**: for to morrow the LORD will do wonders among you.

### 1 Thessalonians 4

<sup>3</sup> For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:

### 1 Thessalonians 4:4

That every one of you should know how to **possess his vessel in sanctification and honour**;

#### Jeremiah 1

<sup>5</sup> Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb **I sanctified thee**, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

### John 10

<sup>35</sup> If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken;

<sup>36</sup> Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

<sup>37</sup> If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.

### John 17

<sup>17</sup> Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

### **Romans 15**

<sup>16</sup> That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.

### Hebrews 9 (cont)

<sup>13</sup> For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer <u>sprinkling</u> the unclean, <u>sanctifieth</u> to the <u>purifying</u> of the flesh:

#### Jude 1

1 Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:

### 1 Corinthians 1

<sup>29</sup> That no flesh should glory in his presence.

<sup>30</sup> But of him are ye in **Christ Jesus**, who of God is **made unto us wisdom**, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

<sup>31</sup> That, according **as it is written**, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.

# Ephesians 5 ...unto the church...

<sup>26</sup> That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word.

### 1 Peter 3

<sup>14</sup>But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled;

<sup>15</sup> But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

<sup>16</sup> Having a **good conscience**; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.

## **A Perfect Lamb**

#### **Hebrews 9**

<sup>14</sup> How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the <u>eternal</u> Spirit <u>offered</u> himself <u>without spot</u> to God, <u>purge</u> your <u>conscience</u> from dead works to <u>serve</u> the living God?

<u>Eternal</u> – <u>NT:166</u> αἰώνιος **aionios** (ahee-o'-nee-os); from <u>NT:165</u>; perpetual (also used of past time, or past and future as well):

*KJV* - eternal, for ever, everlasting, world (began).

<u>Offered</u> – <u>NT:4374</u> προσφέρω **prosphero** (pros-fer'-o); from <u>NT:4314</u> and <u>NT:5342</u> (including its alternate); to bear towards, i.e. lead to, tender (especially to God), treat:

**KJV** - bring (to, unto), deal with, do, offer (unto, up), present unto, put to.

<u>Without spot</u> – <u>NT:299</u> ἄμωμος **amomos** (am'-o-mos); from <u>NT:1</u> (as a negative particle) and <u>NT:3470</u>; unblemished (literally or figuratively):

*KJV* - without blame (blemish, fault, spot), faultless, unblameable.

Purge – NT:2511 καθαρίζω **katharizo** (kath-ar-id'-zo); from NT:2513; to cleanse (literally or figuratively):  $\textbf{\textit{KJV}}$  - (make) clean (-se), purge, purify.

Conscience – NT:4893 συνείδησις **suneidesis** (soon-i'-day-sis); from a prolonged form of NT:4894; coperception, i.e. moral consciousness: KJV - conscience.

<u>Serve</u> – NT:3000 λατρεύω **latreuo** (lat-ryoo'-o); from latris (a hired menial); to minister (to God), i.e. render, religious homage:

**KJV** - serve, do the service, worship (-per).

### 2 Samuel 22

**31** As for God, his way is **perfect**; the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all them that trust in him.

### Psalm 18

**30** As for God, his way is **perfect**: the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.

#### Psalm 19

**7** The law of the LORD is **perfect**, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.

#### **Deuteronomy 32**

**4** He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.

<sup>14</sup> How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the <u>eternal</u> Spirit <u>offered</u> himself <u>without spot</u> to God, <u>purge</u> your <u>conscience</u> from dead works to <u>serve</u> the living God?

### **Deuteronomy 18**

<sup>13</sup> Thou shalt be **perfect** with the LORD thy God.

### 1 Timothy 6

<sup>13</sup> I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and before Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;

<sup>14</sup> That thou **keep this commandment without spot**, **unrebukable**, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:

<sup>15</sup>Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the **King of kings**, and **Lord of lords**;

<sup>16</sup> Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen.

#### 2 Peter 3

<sup>10</sup> But the **day of the Lord** will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

<sup>11</sup> Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness,

<sup>12</sup>Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

<sup>13</sup> Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

<sup>14</sup> Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, **be diligent that ye** may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.

### Matthew 5

<sup>48</sup> Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

#### 1 Peter 1

<sup>16</sup> Because it is written, **Be ye holy; for I am holy.** 

<sup>17</sup> And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons **judgeth** according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:

<sup>18</sup> Forasmuch as ye know that ye were **not redeemed with corruptible things**, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received **by tradition** from your fathers;

<sup>19</sup>But [Redeemed] with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

<sup>20</sup> Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,

<sup>21</sup> Who **by him** do **believe** in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your **faith and hope might be in God**.

## 2 Timothy 3

<sup>16</sup> All **scripture** is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

<sup>17</sup> That the **man of God may be perfect**, **thoroughly furnished** unto all **good works.** 

### James 1

<sup>4</sup> But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may **be perfect** and entire, wanting nothing.

## 2 Corinthians 13

<sup>11</sup> Finally, brethren, farewell. **Be perfect**, be of **good comfort**, be of **one mind**, live in **peace**; and the **God of love and peace shall be with you**.
