We cannot accept the following items at our office:

- furniture
- stuffed animals
- non-kosher food
- perishable food or unwrapped food (e.g., home-baked goods, even if claimed to be kosher)
- electronics (e.g., appliances, computers, video game systems)
- beauty products from unrecognizable companies
- baby formula
- books
- DVDs, videos or videogames
- automobiles
- works of art
- medical equipment or supplies

Tax Receipts for Gifts-in-Kind

As per CRA regulations, JF&CS can only issues tax receipts for new items. The value of the item must be documented.

Documentation required for a tax receipt:

- Proof of purchase, such as a receipt or invoice
 - The receipts must be original receipts
 - The invoice must have donor's name and address on it

JF&CS reserves the right to refuse any items that do not align with its mission or for other reasons as determined by the Donation Department.
