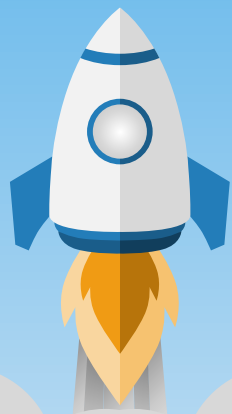




**How HIV does a positive impact on my life?

When I heard that I have HIV for the first time, I thought I will die soon

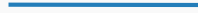


But I'm with you now

That's why I started "Teenergizer"

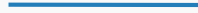
Nobody will understand you better, then person of your age

I still think, that teenagers can make changes

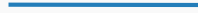
Nobody knows what do we need better, than we ourselves

You can make changes







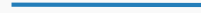
If you really want to do something, just try it.
