Launching the Fatima Centenary!

2017 is Fatima Year. Some of us will go on pilgrimage there, led by Fr de Malleray (enquiries: info@nationalpilgrimagecentre.com).

But even if you can't travel, Our Lady can come to you! We invite every household to sign up and host a statue of Our Lady of Fatima for one week, starting this Saturday 13 May. You will put the statue in a place of honour in your home, and will pray to Our Lady (at least one decade of the Rosary each day). Every weekend, the statue will come back to St Mary's, to be handed by the priest to another household. A grace-filled visit of Our Lady to her children.

May 13 will be a day also to thank God for the canonisation Bl Francesco and Bl Jacinta Marto—two of the three little shepherds—on the 100th anniversary of Our Lady's appearing at Fatima. Francesco loved in his life to do penance for the repentance of souls otherwise destined for hell. Jacinta loved to pray daily for the Holy Father. Let us ask their intercession and aspire to imitate them and Sr Lucia. May Russia convert and spread the Gospel to the world!

SAFEGUARDING IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY: All parishioners from the three parishes of St Benedict's, St Mary's & St Oswald's who have a DBS, and others who are interested, are invited to a Safeguarding Awareness evening in **St Benedict's Parish Centre on Wednesday 17 May, 7–9pm**. It has been some years since parishioners have had some input on safeguarding, and our parish priest, Fr Dave Heywood, asks us to make this meeting a priority as part of our commitment to safeguarding children, young people and vulnerable adults. There will be a novena of singing the *Veni Creator Spiritus* at about 12noon each day from 11-19 May for the five candidates due to receive the **Sacrament of Confirmation** here at St Mary's at 3pm, Saturday 20 May at the hands of the Archbishop Malcolm McMahon, OP. It is a great honour for our Shrine that the Archbishop is coming to confer this Sacrament. We regret there is a diary clash with the *March for Life* (below). Still we encourage people to come to the Confirmations, to witness a wonderful growth in the life in the Church and in the souls of those who will be confirmed.

Holy Communion Reminder:

- To receive Holy Communion, one must be 1) a Roman Catholic 2) in state of grace (no grave sin unabsolved on one's conscience) and 3) have fasted for at least one hour.
- In the traditional Latin rite used at St Mary's, Holy Communion is received kneeling (if one can), and in any case on the tongue: thank you very much in advance.
- Please **use the entire width of the Communion rail**, from one wall of the church all the way to the opposite wall, avoiding any gaps. This will make distribution quicker. Thank you.
