



WINTER CAR SEAT SAFETY TIPS

No bulky winter coats. It can result in the harness being too loose to be effective in a crash.

Put their coat on backwards. Place the coat over the tightened car seat harness to keep you child warm.

Use heavy blankets. To keep your child warm after you remove the bulky coat, place a blanket over the tightened car seat harness.

Wear hats and gloves. This will keep your child warm without effecting the tightness of the car seat harness.

Take the Pinch Test. Use the pinch test year-round to make sure the harness is adjusted correctly. First remove bulky clothing and blankets. Then buckle and tighten the harness straps. Pinch the strap at your child's shoulder. If you are unable to pinch any excess webbing, you're good to go.

Pre-heat the car. When possible, do this to help keep your child warm during travel.
