

TIME WARP FESTIVAL SHOW VEHICLE INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in Time Warp Festival 2017. Please find below Information relating to your Vehicle featuring at this year's event.

VEHICLE ACCESS INFORMATION

FESTIVAL DATE: April 29 2017

REGISTRATION DATE: 1st March

TIME: Road closure will operate between the hours of 8am-6pm

FESTIVAL OPERATING HOURS: 10am-10pm

VEHICLE ENTRY INFORMATION: Show vehicles are only permitted to enter the festival between the hours of 8am-9.30am

VEHICLE EXIT INFORMATION: Show vehicles are only permitted to leave the festival following 5pm. It is essential that all vehicles are clear of the road way in preparation for road re-opening at 6pm. Early departure is available on request.

FEES

Bike (Full Day): \$15

EARLY DEPARTURE

The organisers of Time Warp Festival 2017 understand that It can be a long day to showcase your vehicle. This year we have arranged for persons to be in place for the early departure of your vehicle. This option will incur a **\$5 fee** to cover costs of organising personnel to marshal your vehicle out of the event and the administration of such.

- Safety is heavily enforced to any Vehicle owner that chooses this option.
- Limited Marshalls are available so your patience may be required as we only accept one vehicle to leave the event at a time.

APPLICATION

At Time Warp Festival 2017, due to space restrictions there will be a limited number of vehicle spaces available and it is not expected that all vehicle applications will be accepted. Time Warp Festival 2017 aims to create an environment that is unique and diverse therefore careful consideration will be taken by event organisers to have a diverse range of vehicles for the festival.

It is compulsory to showcase your vehicle for the full course of the festivals trading hours. That is from 10am-5pm. It is essential that all vehicles are completely ready for show by 10am and completely free of the road when Margaret street re-opens at 6pm.

To apply to showcase your vehicle at Time Warp Festival 2017 fill out the registration form on our website – www.timewarpfestival.com.au. Event organizers will endeavour to notify vehicle owners as soon as possible in their success in the application process. Please include as many details of your vehicle as possible.

PRIZES

- Time Warp Festival has no influencing opinion on these judges and does not accept any association with the unfair judging of Vehicles.

SERVICE/ GENERAL INFORMATION

Time Warp Festival operates in conjunction with QLD Police, QLD Highway Patrol and Department of main roads to create a safe and secure event. Both in and around the event road safety is heavily patrolled. Time Warp Festival has a no tolerance approach to the unsafe use of any motor vehicle.

NOISE

Time Warp Festival understands that vehicles showcased at the event can be heavily modified and noise can be an effect of such. Idling noise or just above will be the only acceptable vehicle noise at the event. In and around the event revving or burnouts may result in the vehicles owner being ejected from the festival without reimbursement of fees.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Vehicle registration will admit one vehicle only and is irrespective of size, weight, colour or height. Vehicles with 2 wheels are classified motorbikes. Vehicles with 4 wheels are classified cars.
- It is recommended that vehicle owners bring their own forms of 'please do not touch' signage. Although Time Warp Festival volunteers will be monitoring attendees around vehicles, Time Warp Festival does not accept responsibility for attendees touching vehicles.

- Barricading around vehicles can only be used if prior approval from Festival organisers has been granted.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All Vehicle owners, volunteers and staff are required to adhere to the Festivals code of conduct. Any attendee of the event who is jeopardising the safety of themselves or others, or is acting in a way that is deemed unacceptable, or poses a health risk to themselves or others, or acts in an unlawful manner will be ejected from the event. If said person is a vehicle owner, all fees will be kept by Time Warp Festival and the vehicle owner and vehicle will not be permitted back to the event.

DRINK/ DRUG DRIVING

- It is an offense to drink and drug drive in Queensland. The areas in and around the event will be patrolled by random alcohol and drug testing. Time Warp Festivals organisers hold the right to report vehicle owners to authorities if they suspect they are under the influence of such.

VEHICLE SIGNAGE

- Vehicle owners who use signage to advertise their vehicles must have clear aesthetically appealing signage. Vehicle owners must provide their own means of displaying signs; no poles or ropes will be provided. All signage must be within the area or close proximity to the owners' vehicle.
- The Vehicle Area Manager is permitted to move or remove any signage should the placement, quality or design of it breach festival standards, OHS and/or Fire Regulations.
- Vehicle owners will not be permitted to use sound to attract attention to their vehicle.
- Crude language must not be used when displaying 'please do not touch' signs

VEHICLE ACCESS

- Display vehicles can access the event from 8am-9.30am. Vehicles will be prohibited from moving in the area from 9.30am.
- Whilst in the confines of the event a walking pace speed is enforced to ensure the safety of those around the vehicle.
- Parking will be marshalled by volunteers, it is essential that you obey their instructions. Bear in mind that they are unpaid volunteers and your courtesy will be much appreciated.
- When leaving the event normal road rules apply, all vehicle owners are to be aware of their surroundings and maintain a walking pace speed restriction.

SECURITY

- Time Warp Festival will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to Vehicles at the event. It is the responsibility of the vehicle owner to keep their property safe and secure whilst at the event.
- QLD Police will be assisting event organisers at the Festival.
- **Time Warp Festival takes no responsibility:** Vehicle owners will be responsible for any personal valuables and for the security of their vehicles at all times.

INSURANCE

- In the unlikely event that Time Warp Festival is cancelled prior to opening to the public vehicle fees will be fully refunded. Time Warp Festival will not be liable for any personal issues associated to vehicle owners. The event of a vehicle owner being sick or unable to attend the event is not grounds for refund and Time Warp Festival accepts no responsibility in the matter.
- Vehicle owners are responsible for the insurance cover of their vehicles and personal property whilst at the Festival. Time Warp festival carries no insurance or liability covering vehicle owners, vehicles or personal items.

FIRE, HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- Time Warp Festival takes all responsible precautions to avoid accidents. However, vehicle owners are also required to do all in their power to maintain high safety standards. Please note the following requirements:
- Due to Fire regulations, Vehicle owners must not block or inhibit designated entrance/ exit areas.
- When driving at the event observe and avoid all overhead street decorations and flags which protrude from poles around the site.
- Should Vehicle owners identify Health and Safety hazards or issues which the Vehicle owner is unable to resolve, it is the Vehicle owner's responsibility to inform Time Warp Festival officials or Qld Police immediately.
- Time Warp festival reserves the right to take action to immediately terminate any activity that may be a threat to public safety.

By registering your vehicle and paying your fees you are confirming that you will abide by these terms and conditions.
