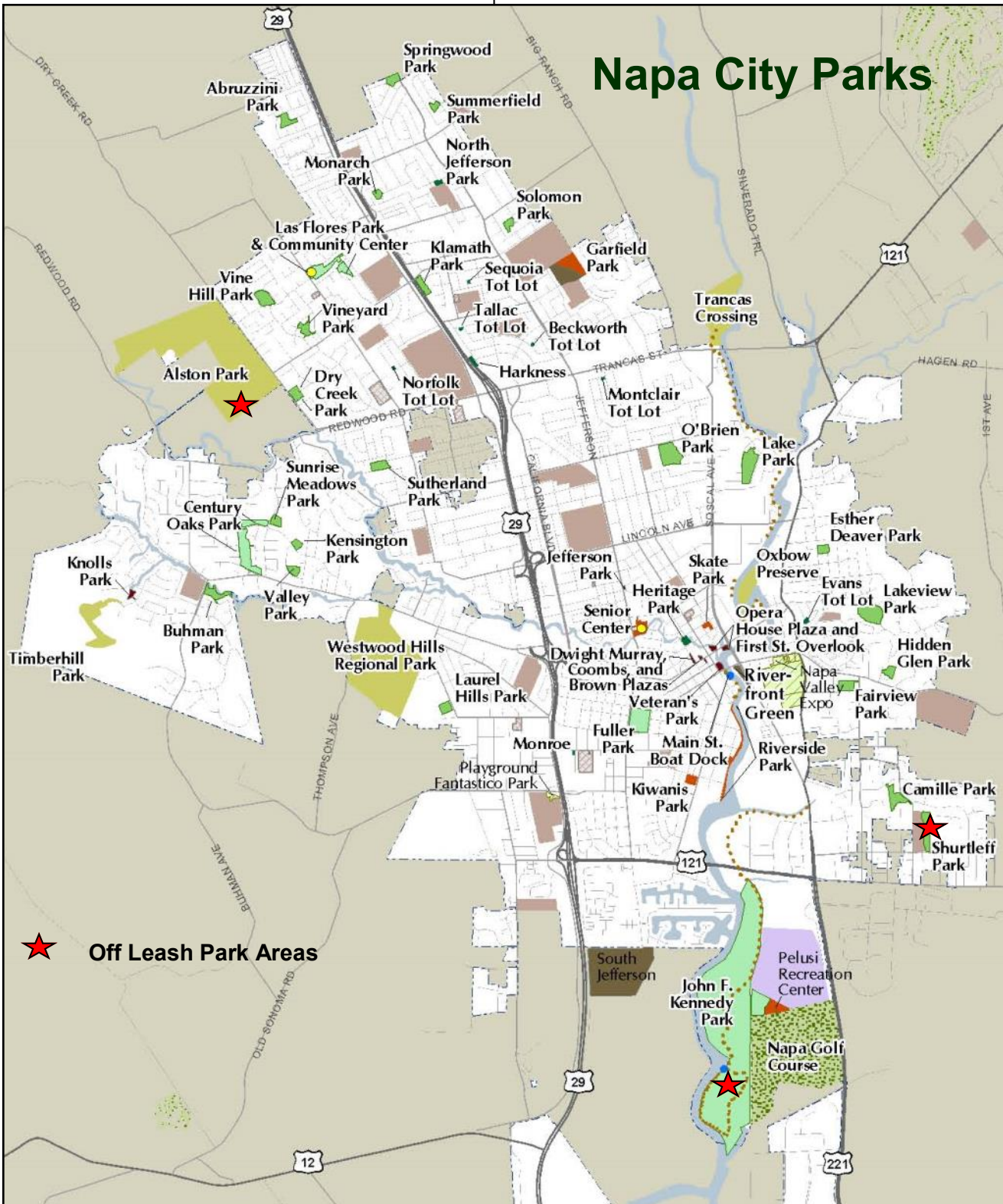

Dogs in City Parks and Recreational Areas

The City of Napa is a pet friendly community. In order to assure that all users have a great recreational experience the following rules and regulations have been put in place related to walking dogs in these areas. These full regulations can be found in sections 6.04.170 and 12.36.190 of the Napa Municipal Code.

 **Dogs are allowed in all City Parks and on public trails on leash.**

 **Dogs are prohibited in any park playground or tot lot.**

 **Dogs are allowed Off Leash under Voice Control at the following parks ;**

Alston Park—2037 Dry Creek Road, 155 acre park with 39 acres designated off leash

Shurtleff Park —1238 Shelter Avenue

Kennedy Park - 3291 Streblov Drive—Undeveloped Areas Only

Here are some other regulations that dog owners need to be aware of.

- 1. Dog owners are responsible for picking up after their dogs.*
- 2. Dogs must have required vaccinations.*
- 3. Dogs must be licensed.*
- 4. No more than 5 dogs per owner/guardian in any off leash area.*
