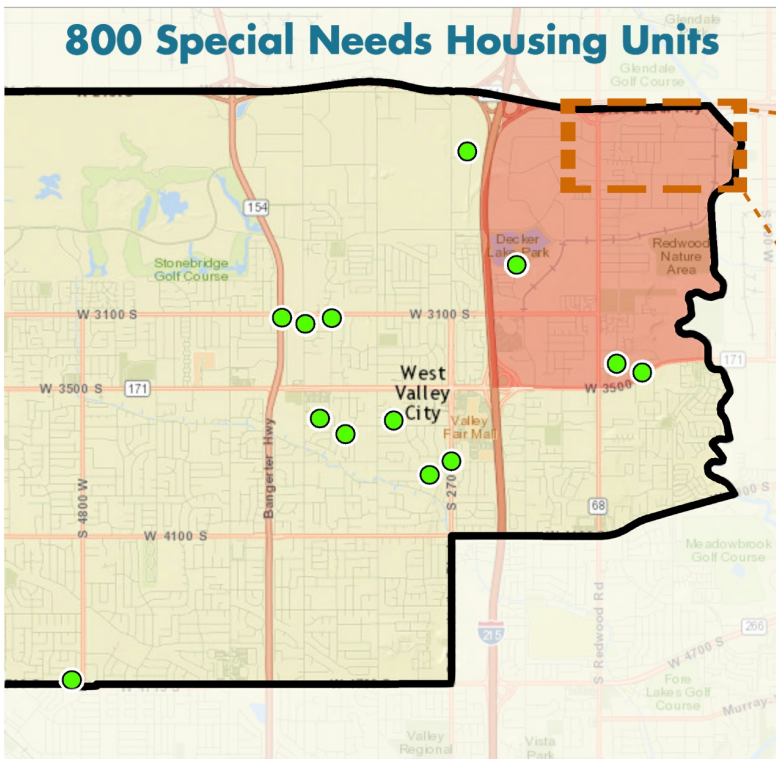
### Tax Credit Projects

housing units

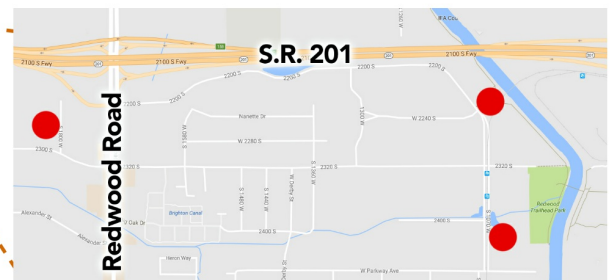
### Rental Units
