### **MINERALS**

**Aragonite (OGS/FER):** Ca source, low Mg. Has 94% of the sweetening effect of limestone. **Nat'l list**

**Azomite pellets (NCO):** (0-0-2.5) 5% Ca, minerals, trace elements. 300-600 #/A or 1-2#/100 ft<sup>2</sup> **OMRI**

**Bone Char (OGS/FER):** (0-16-0) Burned bone meal. High available Phosphorus (P). **OMRI**

**Calphos Colloidal Phosphate (OGS):** (0-2-0) 18% total P, 2% readily available, 21% Ca, trace minerals. Soft rock phosphate. 500-200#/A or 2-5#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. **Nat'l list**

**Dolomitic Lime (OGS):** (8.5% MgCO<sub>3</sub>, 87%CaCO<sub>3</sub>) Use to sweeten soil and provide Ca and Mg. **Nat'l list**

**Granite Meal (OGS):** (0-5-5) Potassium (K) source. Won't effect pH. Improves soil structure, promotes healthier plants. 50-100#/acre. **Nat'l list.**

**Greensand (OGS/NCO):** (0-1-7) 3% Mg, Iron (Fe). Slow release K plus minerals, trace elements. 500-2000#/acre or 2-5#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. **OMRI**

**Gypsum (OGS):** Calcium sulfate. 23% Ca, 17% Sulfur (S). Provides soil Ca without effecting pH. **Nat'l list**

**Hi-Cal Lime (LAP):** 95% CaCO<sub>3</sub>. Use to add Ca raise the pH when Mg is not needed. **Nat'l list.**

**Planters II Minerals (OGS):** Trace minerals 5% Ca, 5% S, 14% Si, brewers yeast. Improves germination,

root formation, plant vigor. 100#/A in rows or 250#/A broadcast. **OMRI**

**Redmond Salt (OGS):** 95% NaCl. **OMRI**

**Sea-90 (LAP):** Sea salt and trace elements. Improves flavor in vegetables 50#/acre or 1.25#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. **OMRI**

**Sulfate of Potash (NCO):** 51% soluble K, 18% S. 200-500#/A, 1# 100 ft<sup>2</sup>. soil test and crop dependent. **OMRI**

**Sul-Po-Mag (FER):** (0-0-22) 11% Mg, 17% S. Immediate K. Use if Mg is also needed. 200-500#/A or 1/2-1#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. Soil test & crop dependent. **Nat'l list**

**TN Brown Phosphate (OGS):** (0-3-0) Consistency of rich soil. 6% readily available P. 300-500#/A. **OMRI**

**Zeolites (OGS):** Improve water and mineral retention in sandy soil. 15-20#/100 ft<sup>2</sup> 2-3#/10# potting soil. **OMRI**

### **FERTILIZERS**

**Alfalfa Meal (OGS/FER):** (2.6-0-2.3 avg) Available N, feeds soil organisms. 800#/A or 2-3#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. **Nat'l list**

**Blood Meal (OGS):** (12-0-0) Available N. Side-dress vegetables at 3/4#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. Can burn, so avoid direct root or stem contact. Use in compost. **Nat'l list**

**Cheep Cheep (NCO):** (4-3-3) Dehydrated poultry litter. Granular. Gardens, lawns. 15-30#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. **OMRI**

**Fish Meal (OGS):** (8-3-0) Excellent source of N and P for side dressing or compost. **Nat'l list**

## **FERTILIZERS (cont.)**

**Kelp Meal (OGS):** Dried, ground seaweed. Trace minerals, enzymes, amino acids. 1#/100 ft<sup>2</sup> or 330-

600#/A. Add to animal feed @ 1-2% of ration. **Nat'l list**

**Menefee Humates (OGS):** 65% humic acid. 250-400#/A/yr in several applications, ½-1#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. **OMRI**

**Soybean Meal (OGS):** (7-0.5-2.3) High levels of N and K released over time. **Nat'l list**

## **FERTILIZER BLENDS**

**Asparagus Mix (LAP):** (1-2-1-7-0-0.5) Improves quality and yield. 75#/100' row after last harvest.

**Blueberry Mix:** (0-3-2-10-0-30) Apply in fall after harvest 2-5# per bush spread evenly in root zone.

**Corn Row Starter:** (2-4-4) All purpose fertilizer with microbiological soil stimulant. 150-300#/A.

**Fall Fruit Tree Prep Mix:** To prepare your land in fall or winter for spring fruit-tree planting, use this mix. Without digging a hole, spread one bag on an area 4-6' in diameter. Cover with ⅛ yd (about 3½ cu ft) of compost and then with ⅛-½ yd of chipped branches and brush. **MOFGA**

**Fruit Tree Planting Mix (OGS):** Well-balanced amendments, humus-rich. TN brown phosphate, alfalfa meal, azomite, K-Mag. 3#/tree hole. **MOFGA**

**Garden Top Dress (LAP):** (2-4-1) Balanced minerals and nutrients with microbiological soil stimulant. Starter fertilizer w/ available N. 25#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>, 7503/A.

**Meadow Top Dress (LAP):** (2-1-4) Balanced minerals and nutrients with microbiological soil stimulant. 150-300#/A at planting time and for spring green-up.

**Pro Booster (NCO):** (10-0-0) 3.5% water soluble N. Blend of vegetable/animal protein meals w/ natural nitrate of soda. Use approx. 1#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>.

**Pro Gro (NCO):** (5-3-4) A high nutrient, general purpose fertilizer for lawns, gardens, orchards, nurseries, and forage. Use approx. 2-3#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. **OMRI**

**Pro Start (NCO):** (2-3-2) For root crops, perennials, legumes, shrubs, and trees. Starter fertilizer for seeds or transplants. Use approx. 2-3#/100 ft<sup>2</sup>. **OMRI**

## **COMPOST PRODUCTS**

**Compost (ICC):** Made with dairy and horse manures, bedding, leaves, etc. **NHDAMF**

**Compost Plus (VCC):** High nutrient blend of compost, organic fertilizers and minerals. Good for potted plants, transplants, and for top dressing seedling in cell trays.

**Vermont Organic Farmers (VOF).**

## **POTTING SOIL**

**Fort Vee (VCC):** Composted manure/plant materials sphagnum, w/ minerals and nutrients. **VOF**

**Fort Light (VCC):** Composted manure/plant materials sphagnum, w/ minerals & nutrients. Lighter **VOF**

**Perlite (ICC):** "Popped" volcanic rock used in potting soil to provide good drainage. **Nat'l list**

**Potting Mix (ICC):** Compost blend with minerals and protein meals. **NHDAMF**

**Seed Start Mix (ICC):** A lighter version of Ideal Compost's Potting mix. Good for plug trays. **NHDAMF**

**Vermiculite (ICC):** "Popped" mica rock. Medium-coarse, standard size for potting soil. **Nat'l list**

## **LIQUIDS AND BIOLOGICS**

**D-Compose (LAP):** Aids breakdown of field debris in fall. 1 qt - 1 gal/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>

**F-1 Foliar Spray (LAP):** Aids disease control in fruits & vegetables. 1 pt - 2.5 gal/1000 ft<sup>2</sup> every 7-10 days.

**Liquid Kelp (OGS):** Natural growth hormones, trace elements. 2 TB/gal H<sub>2</sub>O to seed, root, leaf. **Nat'l list**

**Fish Hydrolysate (OGS):** Conc. liquid fish used as foliar feed. Strain before using in drip irrigation system. 2-4 TB/gal H<sub>2</sub>O Use 1½-3 qt/50 gal H<sub>2</sub>O/A. **OMRI**

**Fish Hydrolysate with Kelp (OGS):** (2-3-1) Improves plant vigor and stress resistance, increases storage life. Use 4 TB/gal H<sub>2</sub>O for soil drench, 2-3 TB/gal H<sub>2</sub>O for foliar spray. Use 1½-3 qt/50 gal H<sub>2</sub>O/A **OMRI**

**Fruit Mix (LAP):** All purpose blend of NPK w/ Ca. Foliar apply every 7-14 days. 1.5 oz - 1 gal/A.

**Seed Gro (LAP):** Aids in germination and early growth. Pre-plant 1 gal-4 gal/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>.

## **ORGANIC COVER CROP SEEDS (OGS)**

**Buckwheat, Common:** Frost-sensitive. Large-seeded Japanese buckwheat. Cover crop 100#/A, 2#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. Grain crop, 50#/A, 1#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. **MOFGA**

**Clover, Red Mammoth:** Short-lived perennial. mow or graze the first year, and plow down the second year. Seed early at 15-20#/A, ½#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. **MOFGA**

**Oats, Everleaf:** Late-heading, vigorous, excellent forage yield. Vigorous seedlings, lush leafy growth outcompete weeds. Spring seed 100#/A, 2-3#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. **MOFGA**

**Peas, Field:** Frost-tolerant, annual. Prefers cool, moist conditions, well-drained loams. Cover crop 100-200#/A, 4#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. Forage 100#/A 4#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup> **MOFGA**

**Peas, Vetch, Oats Soil Building Mix:** Spring sow allow for 60-90 days of growth. Disk or mow and incorporate fall. 200#/A, 5#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. **MOFGA**

**Radish, Tillage:** Daikon penetrates hardpans & loosens soil down to 30". Sow early Sept. Not for spring. Drill at 8-10#/A, broadcast 10-15#/A, ½#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup> **MOFGA**

**Rye, Winter:** Extremely winter-hardy and competitive. Sow Sept-mid Oct. Cover crop 100-200#/A, 3-4#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. Grain, 100-125#/A, 2#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. Incorporate into soil at least 3 weeks before planting. **MOFGA**

**Vetch, Hairy:** Vigorous. N fixation over 100#/acre. Tolerates acidic soils and low fertility, but not poor drainage. 20-40#/A 1#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. Use w/Pea & Vetch inoculant. **MOFGA**

**Vetch/Winter Rye Mix:** 78% rye, 22% vetch by wt. Green manure, adds soil N, suppresses weed growth. 90#/A 2#/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. **MOFGA**

## **INOCULANTS (OGS)**

**Alfalfa/Clover:** For alfalfa, sweet clover and all the *Trifolium* clovers. **OMRI**

**Legume:** For peas, beans (limas, favas, bell, soy), sweet peas, cowpeas, lentils & peanuts. **OMRI**

**Peas/Vetch:** Use w/PVO soil-building mix & vetch rye mix. Also garden peas, lentils, favas, bell beans. **OMRI**

## INOCULANTS (cont.)

**Myco Seed Treat:** Microorganisms & mycorrhizal fungi for potatoes, corn, legumes, grasses & vegetables. Esp. cut seed potatoes. 1–2 oz/100# potato seed pieces, 4–8 oz/100# of other seed. **OMRI**

## PEST AND WEED CONTROL

**Actinovate L&G (OGS):** Beneficial bacteria for control of fungal diseases. Dry powder. Apply as a root drench or foliar spray 3–12 oz/150 gal H<sub>2</sub>O /A **OMRI**

**Bonide Copper (OGS):** A copper fungicide. 1½–2 oz/gal H<sub>2</sub>O every 7–10 days in wet periods. **MOFGA**

**Diatomaceous Earth (LAP):** Agricultural food grade. Used as barrier for crawling pests & in animal feed. Do not exceed 2% of total ration. **Nat'l list**

**DiPel DF Bt Powder (OGS):** Dry, flowable, wettable powder. Commercial strength Bt for chewing caterpillar control. Use w/ThermX 70 to improve adhesion. **OMRI**

**Garlic Barrier (OGS/NOC):** 99.3% garlic juice repels insects. Quart covers 80,000 sq ft. Gallon covers 20 acres. **OMRI**

**Milky Spore (OGS):** Kills Japanese Beetle grubs, not adults. Spread on the lawn 1t/every 4' in 4' rows. **OMRI**

**Monterey Garden Spray (OGS):** 0.5% solution of spinosads for insect control on crops. Avoid spraying during flowering & pollination. 1–2 oz/gal for all crops. Registered for home garden use only. **OMRI**

**Rootshield H&G (OGS):** Beneficial fungal treatment. Seed drench, 1–3 Tbsp/gal H<sub>2</sub>O/25' row. Same dilution for transplants & established plants ½–1c/plant. **OMRI**

**Safer Insecticidal Soap (OGS):** Biodegradable contact insecticide. 2½ oz/gal H<sub>2</sub>O. **OMRI**

**Serenade Concentrate (OGS):** Bacterial fungicide for vegetable & fruit crop bacterial and fungal diseases.

~4 oz/gal H<sub>2</sub>O, 5- to 7-day intervals as needed. **OMRI**

**Surround WP (OGS):** Crop protectant is 95% kaolin clay. 25#/50 gal H<sub>2</sub>O for concentrated use; 25#/100 gal H<sub>2</sub>O for diluted spray, ½#/gal H<sub>2</sub>O in hand and backpack sprayers. **OMRI**

**ThermX 70 (OGS):** A wetting agent and spreader-sticker. 1–2 pints/A using sufficient water for thorough coverage. Mix 8 oz/100 H<sub>2</sub>O as wetting agent or spreader-sticker. Add as the last as it foams a lot. **OMRI**

**Vinegar, 200 grain (LAP):** white vinegar, 20% acetic acid.

## SUPPLIES (OGS)

**Agribon AG 19 Row Cover:** For pest and frost protection 0.55oz/sq yd.

**Black Plastic Mulch:** All-purpose plastic mulch for cool-weather areas. Recommended for tomatoes, cucurbits and sweet corn. 1.0 mil thick, 4' wide.

**Deer X Fencing:** Temporary fencing to protect crops from deer, birds & other pests. Black polypropylene ¾" mesh with UV inhibitors.

**Tomato Stakes:** Bundle of 25. 6' long.

**Trellis Plus:** 7" reach-through nylon mesh with a strand strength of 60# for tomatoes and climbers.

**White on Black Plastic Mulch:** Recommended for strawberries, onions, brassicas and lettuce.

**Wire Hoops:** Straight 74" flexible rods of 10-gauge wire for use with row covers.
