

REGISTRATION FEES FOR VESSELS USING THE RIVER CAM UPSTREAM OF BOTTISHAM LOCK FROM 1 APRIL 2016 TO 31 MARCH 2017

In accordance with their Byelaws, the Conservators have laid down the registration fees for vessels using the Conservancy Area in the year commencing 1 April 2016 as set out below.

Visiting sailcraft must have a valid registration for the Conservancy Area. An annual visitor licence can be purchased in advance and are valid for a period of up to 90 days. Minimum fee is £10 or 5% of annual license fee.

Visiting powered boats must have a valid registration for the Cam. An annual visitor licence can be purchased and are valid for a period of up to 90 days within the registration year. Gold license holders may purchase a visitor license at the lower rate of 3% of the annual fee (minimum fee of £10).

Power driven vessels - Commercial (Class D)

Operators of commercial vessels based above Bottisham Lock are required to pay a multiplier on the fees set out in the table above for power driven vessels, as:

- 1.2 x relevant annual fee for day hire craft
- 1.8 x relevant annual fee for annual / long-term hire
