

The Kingdom of God – Part 17: Kingdom Finances

Summary

God being the servant is determined by money being your master. Money was never designed to meet your needs. God is designed to meet your needs. The biggest test of our lives is based on our relationship with finances. What you do with money, determines whether you can handle the anointing. We cannot fulfill the expression of who God made us to be without the anointing.

A. The Anointing and Finances

- a. We have a relationship with possessions. With wrong revelation it hinders us from receiving the anointing of God which is a vital importance for our lives.
- b. The anointing breaks the yoke of bondage over our lives, empowers us to do acts of service, empowers us to do what we've been called to do, and manifests the purposes that God has for our lives.
- c. If Jesus needed the anointing over His life to do and be, we cannot function and be fulfilled with the expression of who God made us, without that anointing too.
- d. Jesus' first message was from Isaiah 61. (Isaiah 61:1)
- e. When you believe that God blesses you, to take you out and separate you to enjoy the things He's blessed you with – you have been deceived by riches. He's blessed you financially to keep you in the church, to bless others.
- f. The description and where your reality is, is described by your passions and desires.
- g. Seek first the Kingdom – am I? Is it the Kingdom first or the blessings first? (Romans 14:17)
- h. Kingdom of God is built on sacrifice – where there is no sacrifice, there is no expression of the Kingdom of God.
- i. Are you becoming more faithful when you get more finances? That's the biggest test.
- j. You can't be a light out in the world, if you can't be a light to your brother in the church. You can't love out in the world, if you can't love your brother in the church.
- k. We are the body of Christ – the anointed one and his anointing. You are the body of the anointing. You are the housing of the glory, presence and anointing of God himself.

B. Forgiveness of Sins

- a. Forgiveness of sins is for us, not the unsaved.
- b. When someone comes to know Jesus they confess that Jesus died for my sins, but to confess Jesus is not the confession of sins.
- c. You just have to believe in your heart, this brings regeneration and instantly transforms a person from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of light. (Romans 10:9-10).
- d. The message of repentance from dead works is for the unsaved.
- e. Repentance – change of mind, not confession.
- f. Most of the Bible is actually written for us as the church, not the lost.

- g. Your saved experience is really after the born again experience.

C. God is Your Master, Not Money

- a. Love is a relational word. It is in expressing the relationship you have with that person. (1 Timothy 6:10)
- b. It's either that God is the master and you are the servant or you are the master and God is the servant. God being the servant is determined by money being your master. (Matthew 6:24)
- c. Servants work for their inheritance or their pay. Sons inherit their money. If you are working for your inheritance, you're the slave of the money. If you're inheriting it, the money is your slave. (Galatians 4:1)
- d. Are you getting what you're getting because you're seeking the Kingdom of God? Are you getting what you're getting by your skill? Because even the heathen have skill.
- e. The treasures of darkness belong to you – they have to be recovered by you.
- f. Money needs you. Money's a loving tool to express the love of God.
- g. You don't need money to expand, you need vision and revelation to expand.
- h. Do you need money to give? Money needs you so you can give it.
- i. What you do with money, determines whether you can handle the anointing.
- j. A master talks, gives orders, has authority and gives commands. You are a master and you give orders. Command your faith. Command your money. (Luke 17:7-10)
- k. Money in or not in the pocket still speaks.
- l. Money was never designed to meet your needs. God is designed to meet your needs.
- m. Money is spiritual first, not natural first.
- n. What determines if God's your master – is that you're seeking the Kingdom of God first. (Galatians 6:9, Matthew 19:29, Deuteronomy 8:18)
- o. God has a plan for your life and it's not determined by money.
- p. We need to live by design not by default. Your design is not determined by what you have.
- q. You must have vision, it is then that you'll attract provision. God put vision and provision in your heart. Everything will bend towards you when you work from a place of vision.
