

# REVEAL in the bible

- Gen 35:7 and there he built an altar and called the place El-bethel, because there God had revealed himself to him when he fled from his brother.
- 41:25 Then Joseph said to Pharaoh, "The dreams of Pharaoh are one; God has revealed to Pharaoh what he is about to do.
- Deut 29:29 "The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things that are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.
- 1 Sam 2:27 And there came a man of God to Eli and said to him, "Thus says the Lord, 'Did I indeed reveal myself to the house of your father when they were in Egypt subject to the house of Pharaoh?'  
3:7 Now Samuel did not yet know the Lord, and the word of the Lord had not yet been revealed to him.  
21 And the Lord appeared again at Shiloh, for the Lord revealed himself to Samuel at Shiloh by the word of the Lord.  
9:15 Now the day before Saul came, the Lord had revealed to Samuel:
- 1 Chron 17:25 For you, my God, have revealed to your servant that you will build a house for him. Therefore your servant has found courage to pray before you.
- Job 20:27 The heavens will reveal his iniquity, and the earth will rise up against him.  
38:17 Have the gates of death been revealed to you, or have you seen the gates of deep darkness?  
Ps 19:2 Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge.  
98:2 The Lord has made known his salvation; he has revealed his righteousness in the sight of the nations.
- Prov 11:13 Whoever goes about slandering reveals secrets, but he who is trustworthy in spirit keeps a thing covered.  
20:19 Whoever goes about slandering reveals secrets; therefore do not associate with a simple babbler.  
25:9 Argue your case with your neighbor himself, and do not reveal another's secret,
- Isa 16:3 "Give counsel; grant justice; make your shade like night at the height of noon; shelter the outcasts; do not reveal the fugitive;  
22:14 The Lord of hosts has revealed himself in my ears: "Surely this iniquity will not be atoned for you until you die," says the Lord God of hosts.  
23:1 The oracle concerning Tyre. Wail, O ships of Tarshish, for Tyre is laid waste, without house or harbor! From the land of Cyprus it is revealed to them.  
40:5 And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the Lord has spoken."  
53:1 Who has believed what he has heard from us? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?  
56:1 Thus says the Lord: "Keep justice, and do righteousness, for soon my salvation will come, and my righteousness be revealed.
- Jer 33:6 Behold, I will bring to it health and healing, and I will heal them and reveal to them abundance of prosperity and security.
- Dan 2:19 Then the mystery was revealed to Daniel in a vision of the night. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven.  
22 he reveals deep and hidden things; he knows what is in the darkness, and the light dwells with him.  
28 but there is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries, and he has made known to King Nebuchadnezzar what will be in the latter days. Your dream and the visions of your head as you lay in bed are these:  
29 To you, O king, as you lay in bed came thoughts of what would be after this, and he who reveals mysteries made known to you what is to be.  
30 But as for me, this mystery has been revealed to me, not because of any wisdom that I have more than all the living, but in order that the interpretation may be made known to the king, and that you may know the thoughts of your mind.  
47 The king answered and said to Daniel, "Truly, your God is God of gods and Lord of kings, and a revealer of mysteries, for you have been able to reveal this mystery."  
10:1 In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a word was revealed to Daniel, who was named Belteshazzar. And the word was true, and it was a great conflict. And he understood the word and had understanding of the vision.
- Hos 7:1 When I would heal Israel, the iniquity of Ephraim is revealed, and the evil deeds of Samaria; for they deal falsely; the thief breaks in, and the bandits raid outside.
- Amos 3:7 "For the Lord God does nothing without revealing his secret to his servants the prophets.
- Matt 10:26 "So have no fear of them, for nothing is covered that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known.  
11:25 At that time Jesus declared, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children;  
27 All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.  
16:17 And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven.
- Luke 2:26 And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ.  
35 (and a sword will pierce through your own soul also), so that thoughts from many hearts may be revealed."  
10:21 In that same hour he rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will.  
22 All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him."  
12:2 Nothing is covered up that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known.  
17:30 so will it be on the day when the Son of Man is revealed.
- John 1:31 I myself did not know him, but for this purpose I came baptizing with water, that he might be revealed to Israel."  
12:38 so that the word spoken by the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled: "Lord, who has believed what he heard from us, and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?"  
21:1 After this Jesus revealed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias, and he revealed himself in this way.  
14 This was now the third time that Jesus was revealed to the disciples after he was raised from the dead.
- Rom 1:17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."  
18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.  
2:5 But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed.  
8:18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.  
19 For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God.
- 1 Cor 1:7 so that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ,  
2:10 these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God.  
3:13 each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done.
- 2 Cor 7:12 So although I wrote to you, it was not for the sake of the one who did the wrong, nor for the sake of the one who suffered the wrong, but in order that your earnestness for us might be revealed to you in the sight of God.
- Gal 1:16 was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with anyone;  
3:23 Now before faith came, we were held captive under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith would be revealed.
- Eph 3:5 which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit.
- Phil 3:15 Let those of us who are mature think this way, and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal that also to you.
- Col 1:26 the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints.
- 2 Thess 1:7 and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels  
2:3 Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction,  
6 And you know what is restraining him now so that he may be revealed in his time.  
8 And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord Jesus will kill with the breath of his mouth and bring to nothing by the appearance of his coming.
- 1 Pet 1:5 who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.  
12 It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.  
4:13 But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed.  
5:1 So I exhort the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed:
- Rev 15:4 Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship you, for your righteous acts have been revealed."
