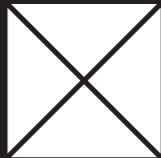
From the vast Tonsley development, Australia's first innovation district, to the House on Mayfair – this year's Marjorie Simpson Small project award winner.

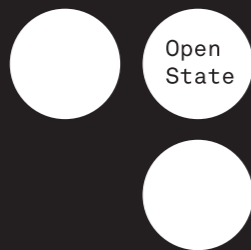
