The meeting was realized thanks the support of 10 sponsors.

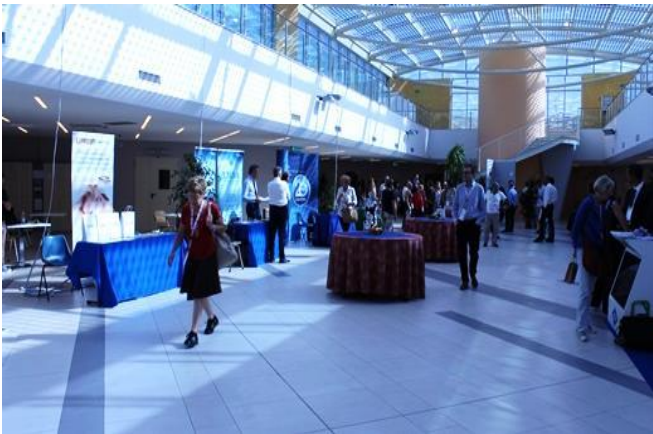

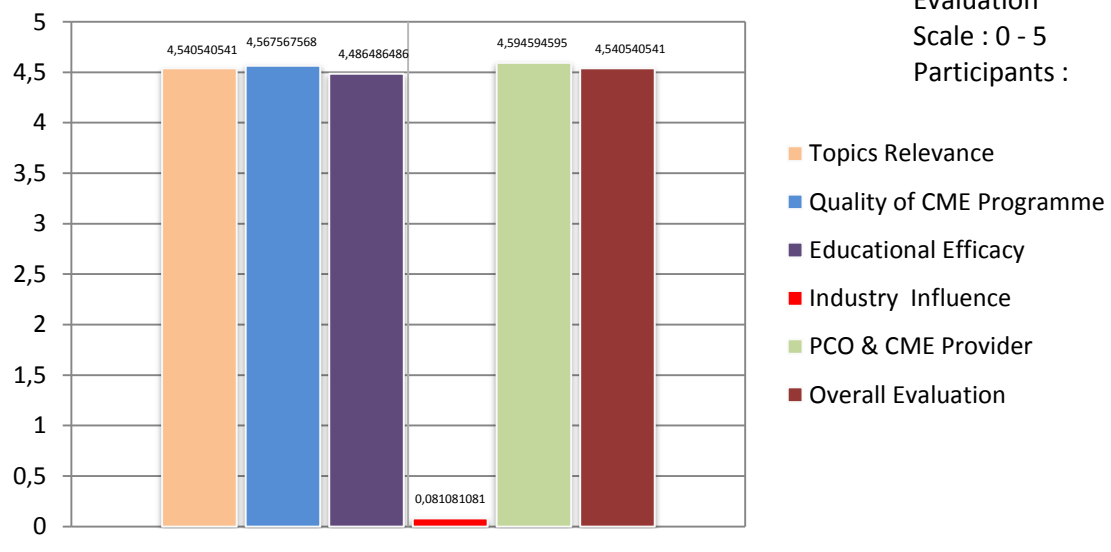

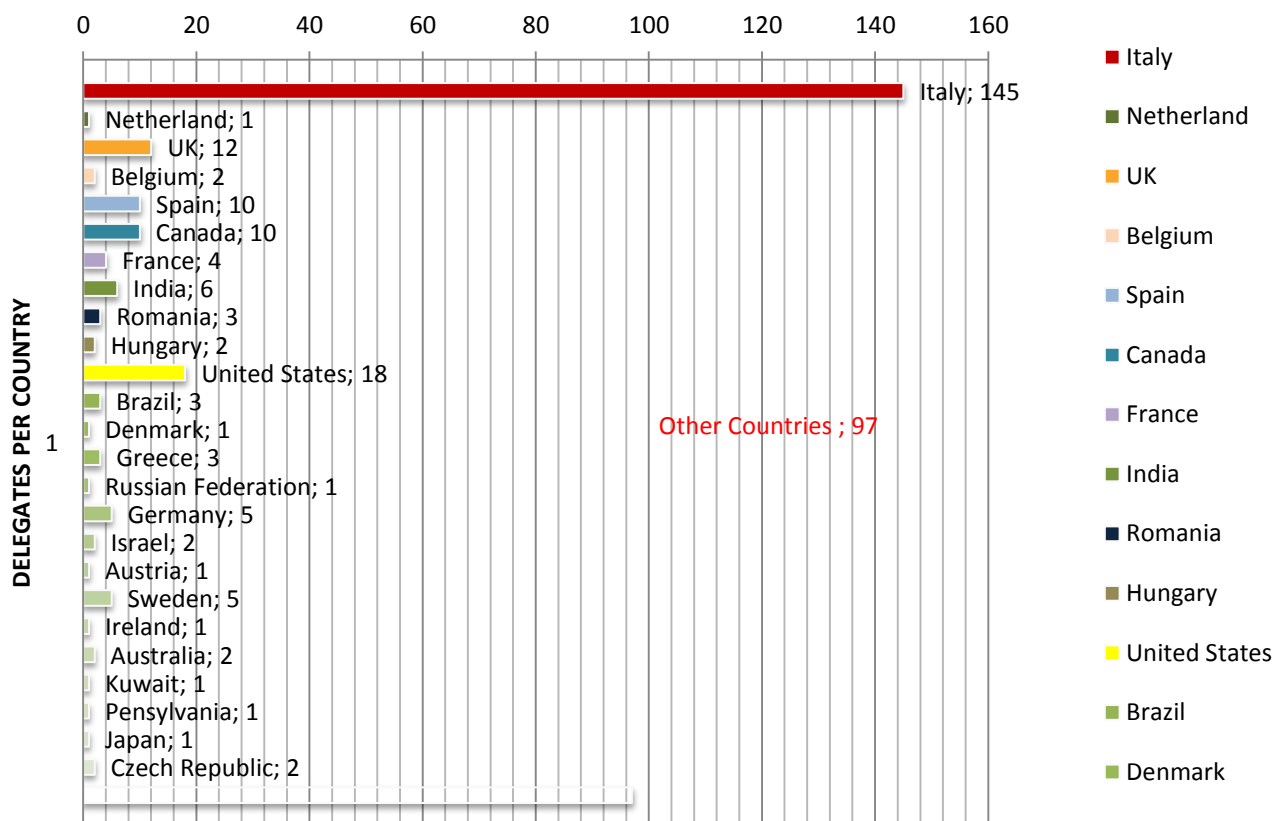

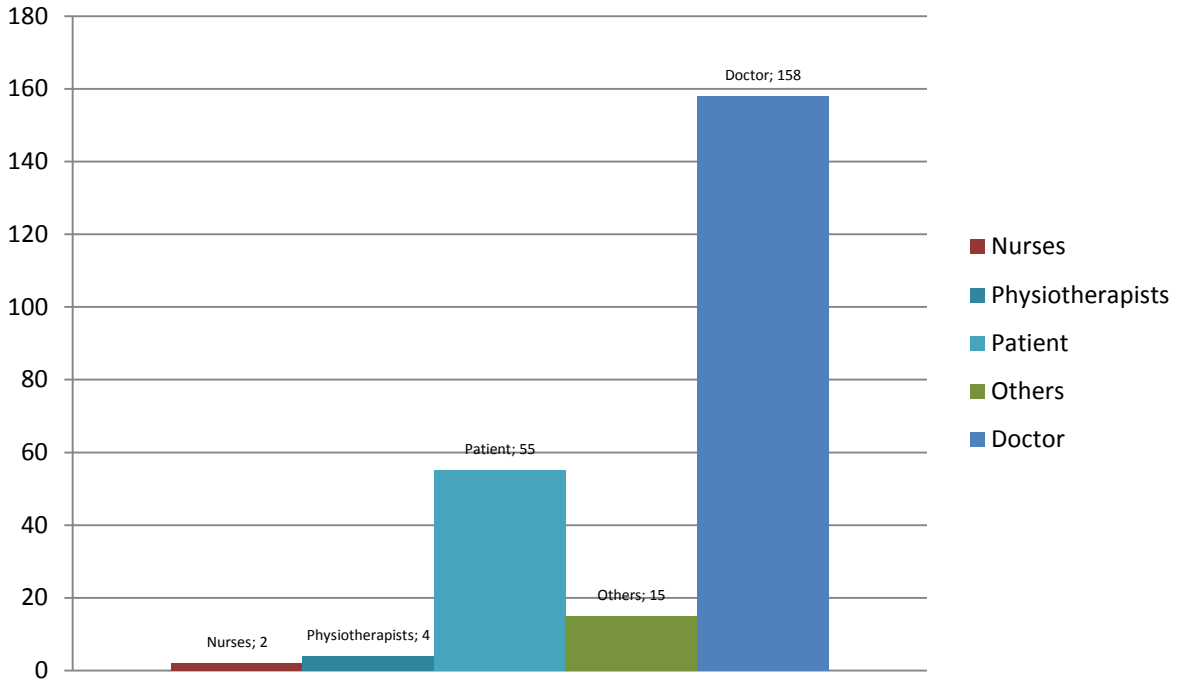
