
Theatre

The show is on May 5,6,12, and 13 at 6 PM, with a special faculty show on May 10. Tickets are on sale at showtix4u.com.




SRHS Wrestling


Flag Football

Closed Campus

All CCSD schools operate under a closed campus policy. After arriving at school, students are not to leave school either during a class period, between class periods, or during lunch without a passport. Passports for appointments or other non-illness reasons may be obtained with parental permission in the attendance office. Students who need to go home during the school day due to illness must check out through the nurse's office. Violators are subject to a disciplinary consequence. Once students enter the building, they may not be outside the building unless permission has been granted. This means that a student may not go to his/ her vehicle unless permission has been given.

Attendance — Denial Of Credit

We mail attendance notifications for students with unapproved absences. Parents and students should monitor and check for attendance errors through their Infinite Campus account. We process letters when a student accrues their 3rd, 5th, and 7th unapproved absences. The 7th unapproved absence letter is the Denial of Credit Notification. The student has accrued more than six (6) unapproved absences in the class. The Clark County School District Regulation 5113 limits unapproved absences in any class to six (6) per semester. Students will not earn credit for that course that semester and may be retained in the same grade. If a parent/guardian believes that extenuating circumstances, issues that may have led to the excessive absence and/or mistakes in the record have been made, the parent may appeal to the principal/designee.

Cell Phone & Electronic Devices

CCSD/Shadow Ridge High School Cell Phone & personal electronic devices Guidelines

These guidelines include the following:

Limited Use: Students are permitted to use cellular phone and personal electronic devices during instructional day in accordance with instructional activities and classroom procedures as outlined by their classroom teacher. Within this setting, students are expected to follow teacher directions regarding when devices may be used, when they can be out, and when they must be put away. Use of cellular phones and personal electronic devices in other instructional settings is prohibited

During all other times:

- » Cellular phones must be turned off and remain off during instructional time and passing periods. Phones left on silent or vibrate are considered in use and will be subject to confiscation.
- » Cellular phones may only be used prior to the first bell, after the final bell, or during your student's scheduled lunch period.
- » Cellular phones must be stored out of sight during school hours in the student's pocket, backpack, or purse.
- » Those in violation of this policy will have their cellular phones confiscated by school staff. Phones will be returned during non-instructional hours to a parent or guardian only.
- » Cellular phones must remain in the off position during a school evacuation, lockdown, or drill to make emergency communication possible for CCSD employees.
- » As a condition of possessing a device on campus, the student agrees to a search of the device's content during a disciplinary investigation if the search is necessary to determine involvement.

We empathize with families trying to meet their scheduling needs, but we cannot allow technology to be used in a detrimental or dangerous manner in our schools. We seek your support and hope that you will speak with your child so they too understand the importance of following this policy. Their safety is of paramount importance to us. We are equally committed to having a quality of instructional time and ensure the safety of your child. Help us make this a successful and safe school year for everyone.
