



beyond the reef

“tablet sleeve for my sister - in - law”

hand maker fabrics

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for this 8” x 10” finished size sleeve you will need about one yard total scraps (for diversity) for top
two fat quarters for lining,
two (2) 2-1/2” prepared binding strips
and 10” x 22” batting and backing
(note: measure tablet; add 1” all sides to determine finished dimensions of sleeve)

cut/sew backing together; layer backing and batting
with batting side up, starting at one end of the 10” x 22” piece,
place one small scrap of fabric right side up
select second scrap of fabric, put right sides together, sew seam
flip open; quilt with straight lines
continue this quilt as you go technique until 10” x 22” piece of batting is covered
trim to required size for sleeve (1” larger all around)
bind top and bottom of short sides
fold in half; bind left and right sides tucking in raw edge of binding at top/bottom
