AAU MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN ALLEVENTS.

All athletes (solo and team) MUST be AAU members and must be able to provide AAU Membership numbers when submitting entry forms. AAU membership MUST BE OBTAINED prior to submitting entry (**NOTE AGES 18+:** Membership is not instant so please allow several days to process).

AAU BATON RULES WILL BE FOLLOWED FOR ALL EVENTS.

GENERAL CONTEST INFO:

- **DOOR ADMISSION AND PROCESSING FEES:** There will be a \$20 facility/processing fee for all performers in solo events. No door fee will be charged for spectators; the facility fee will be in place of a door fee. All solo participants should pay the fee with their solo entry. **NEW THIS YEAR:** There is NOT a separate processing fee for team members; only for those doing solo events.
- **PAYMENT:** If mailing entry: Money order or Cashier's Check only for all mailed entries. Make payable to: Cynthia Bryant. If submitting online and using Square: please contact the contest director for specific entry and PayPal information. A 3% online fee will be added to all PayPal transactions. All fees due with entries by May 19, 2017. No refunds on entry fees or credits to other competitions will be given.
- **TEAM ROSTERS:** All directors must submit one roster for each team entry entered. Rosters should also be provided at "on-deck" check in for each routine the day of the competition.
- **CHANGES TO ENTRIES:** The contest director reserves the right to make any changes necessary. No changes by contestants may be made once an entry is received. ONLY errors made by the contest director will be corrected the day of the contest. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE CONTEST.**
- **PROGRAM BOOKS:** Programs will be sold for \$5.00 each at the check-in/awards table. All solo participants will need a program in order to know lane assignments.
- **FOOD:** A concession stand will be provided during the day. No outside food or drink is allowed in the facility.
- **MUSIC:** All team and solo events that require music (other than standard march music) must submit a CD of your music with your entry form (Cd's will be returned at check-in). You may also email a MP3 file to the contest director by the May 12th entry deadline. Music will be placed on an iPod to be played through the sound system at the contest. Team directors and Solo Twirlers should also bring two back-up copies of your music on a CD to the contest in case a back-up is needed. Music director at contest will be available at 7:45am the day of the contest for individuals and team directors to check their songs on the playlist.
- **WAIVERS:** A waiver must be signed and returned with entry for every participant in the competition (solo and team members). Participants will not be allowed to participate unless a form has been properly filled out and signed by parent/legal guardian/self.

A bid to compete in the National Championships will be awarded to all of those who have entered the required categories for their Championship level.

Texas Multi-Baton Champion Grand Champion: Perform Multi-Baton Solo

- Solo Multi-Baton determines competition level. Levels Offered: Beg, Adv
