

**STORYLINE NABS 2014 CANADIAN SCREEN AWARD FOR
“BEST HISTORY DOCUMENTARY PROGRAM OR SERIES”**

Storyline Entertainment’s *The Real Inglorious Bastards* has won the 2014 Canadian Screen Award for Best History or Biography Documentary Program or Series. The film also received nominations for best direction (Min Sook Lee) and best editing (David Kazala). *The Real Inglorious Bastards* previously won top honours at the GI Film Festival and the Yorkton Film Festival. Min Sook Lee won the 2009 Donald Brittain Award (Gemini) for the Storyline feature *Tiger Spirit*.

Storyline CEO and *The Real Inglorious Bastards* producer Ed Barreveld says: “Storyline was very honoured to receive eight nominations this year. *The Real Sherlock Holmes* and *Herman’s House* also received best program nominations in their categories, so winning this award was very special because we were able to celebrate it with the Storyline team.

“Min Sook and I feel privileged to have been able to document and share the incredible stories of three remarkable men, who risked their lives in a covert operation that took them behind enemy lines toward the end of World War II,” Barreveld adds.
