HELPFUL INFORMATION

All Out-of-Country and US Territories driver's license transfers must be done at the **DMV Cranston headquarters (<http://www.dmv.ri.gov/>). These transactions are not performed at DMV branch locations or AAA branch offices.

The computerized knowledge exam is available Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm at the DMV Cranston headquarters. A vision test will be given at this time. No appointment is necessary. Please allow ample time as this is a high traffic office. Tests are given on a first-come, first-serve basis.

International Driving Permits: Although many countries do not recognize United States driver's licenses, most countries accept an International Driving Permit (IDP). An IDP functions as an official translation of a US driver's license into 10 foreign languages. For additional information please visit: www.dmv.ri.gov.

- LETTER FROM THE OISS OFFICE**
You will need a letter showing enrollment on our letterhead.
Please fill out the Driver's License/State ID Letter Request form and submit it to our office.
Your letter will take 3-5 business days to process so please plan accordingly.
- SOCIAL SECURITY CARD**
Or a denial letter from the Social Security Administration (SSA) office. Bring your passport and I-94 to the SSA office and request a denial letter. The SSA will issue you a letter while you wait that says that you are not eligible for a Social Security number.

- PROOF OF RESIDENCY**
On campus, please obtain letter from Residence Life. You can request a letter at rlo@risd.edu and it will take 2-4 business days to process.
