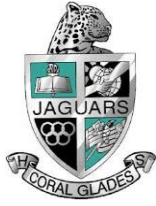

AICE Psychology can count for either Group 1 or Group 3 towards the AICE diploma, and it is considered an academic elective to colleges. However, it counts as an **elective** credit on the high school transcript- not a math or science credit.

The State of Florida mandates that students take the following credits to receive a 24-credit high school diploma:

- a. *Four credits in English Language Arts.*
- b. *Four credits in mathematics.*—A student must earn one credit in Algebra I and one credit in Geometry.
- c. *Three credits in science.*—Two of the three required credits must have a laboratory component. A student must earn one credit in Biology I and two credits in equally rigorous courses.
- d. *Three credits in social studies.*—A student must earn one credit in United States History; one credit in World History; one-half credit in economics, which must include financial literacy; and one-half credit in United States Government. The United States History EOC assessment constitutes 30 percent of the student's final course grade.
- e. *One credit in fine or performing arts, speech and debate, or practical arts.*
- f. *One credit in physical education.*—Physical education must include the integration of health.
- g. *Eight credits in electives.*
