Raising Creative Thinkers

1) Explore – How do I introduce the learning material?  
(Video, Power-Point, story, art, short lecture)

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3 things to remember to talk about during introduction:

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What perspective about the subject will make the learners curious?

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2) Experience – What sort of experiential activity will I lead to foster imagination, playfulness, openness, optimism, enthusiasm, cognitive flexibility, and/or cooperative behavior? (game, role playing, drawing, free writing, coloring, science experiment, conversation about ideas and insights drawn on)

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3) Examine – Points to consider while checking the ideas the kids drew on to foster perspective taking and behavior and emotion regulation:

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4) Elevate – Ideas I could provide to recommend how to develop students' ideas into original educational products to promote constructive behavior, planning, self-directness, self-efficacy, reaching higher and a growth mindset: (Educational product: PP, video, art, creative writing or as the student wishes)

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5) Express – To who will the students present their products in a safe environment (group, all class, relevant audience from the community):

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Expressions I can use during presentations to build self-esteem, values, empathy, and proactive behavior: I like your suggestion that...  
This is a very interesting idea... Can you elaborate on why you've chosen to make this product... I like how you treated your mates...  
This was very considerate of you... Thank you for contributing...
