By wave sheaf day, which is April 16<sup>th</sup> for Linda and I, there will be a lot of kernel ready grain for harvest and grinding in all 3 regions.

This past week the first of the white stork flight started. This migration will intensify for the next 2 weeks and then taper off for another 2 weeks. Right on time!
