

According to Ontario Regulation 667/98 (Trapping), made under the *Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act, 1997*, a trapping licence may be issued to an applicant who is at least 12 years of age and under 16 years of age, if the applicant files with the application a consent. The consent must be signed by both parents, if the applicant resides with them or by one parent or guardian in all other cases. The *Letter of Consent* must be signed and submitted annually along with an *Ontario Trapping Licence – Application for Renewal* to obtain a Secondary Trapping Licence (Youth). Youth trappers will also be required to submit a *Mandatory Season-End Harvest Report* by June 10th of each licence year, which indicates the quantity of fur harvested, sold and kept on hand.
