

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Fast Fact

Medical review contractors, such as the Comprehensive Error Rate Testing (CERT) program, continue to find errors for missing or inadequate signatures on progress notes, office notes, and orders for services and supplies.

Electronic medical records and ordering systems are accepted by CMS if documentation received is otherwise in compliance with CMS record keeping requirements. With electronic systems, CMS review contractors may request a copy of a protocol, policy or procedure that describes how electronic health records are signed and dated in order to verify that the documentation has been electronically signed by the ordering/treating professional. Providers need a system and software products that are protected against modification.

The Medicare Parts C and D Fraud, Waste, and Abuse Training and Medicare Parts C and D General Compliance Training has been revised. This was previously a PowerPoint (PPT) presentation that users would download.

The **NEW FREE** (1) Medicare Parts C and D General Compliance Training and (2) Combating Medicare Parts C and D Fraud, Waste and Abuse training courses, listed below, provide separate content for compliance and FWA, and provide web-based versions that are printable and PDF versions that are downloadable. The training content is generic since various entities (e.g., health plans, labs, hospitals, providers, etc.) complete the training. A certificate of completion (which includes contact hours) is generated upon passing a short test with a score of 70% or higher at the end of each web-based training (WBT).

There is no continuing education (CE) with these 2 WBTs but contact hours are included on the certificate of completion.

Please check with your licensing body to see if they will accept the certificate of completion with the contact hours.






