Posters do not need to necessarily follow traditional poster templates but should be organized to tell your story for others to learn and appreciate your efforts. The poster should include your project title, project background information, materials and methods, literature cited, acknowledgments, results, conclusions and contact information for further information if requested.

All poster submissions will be reviewed and accepted by the National EMS Safety Summit Leadership Planning Committee. Approvals will be determined and communicated to poster submitters by July 15, 2017.
