

DAC GALLERY SUMMER 2017 CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Downtown Art Center (DAC) Gallery is seeking submissions for a group exhibition that will take place **June 3rd - July 7th, 2017**. This call is open to all artists within the continental United States and there is no submission fee. An opening reception will be held on **Saturday, June 3rd** from **6-8PM**.

Although the range of accepted mediums is largely open (please see the list of mediums in the submission guidelines), the gallery is interested in emphasizing artwork that is wholly or in part, made from fiber-based materials.

DEADLINES

Submissions must be received by e-mail on or before 4PM on May 12, 2017 at info@dacgallery.com. **PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT CDS, SLIDES, OR PRINTS.**

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Mediums: fiber-based materials strongly preferred, however, the following mediums will also be considered: painting, printmaking, drawing, photography, ceramics, performance.
- Submissions will only be accepted via email to info@dacgallery.com Up to 20 images may be submitted in .jpg format (approx. resolution, 1600 pixels, 72 dpi). The body of your e-mail must include a list of titles, dimensions, medium, and year of completion for each image submitted. Please label your files accordingly. The gallery will not accept submissions without this information. All submitted artworks must be original.
- An artist statement and CV must accompany each submission.
- Presentation: Framed and unframed artworks will be considered for exhibition. If you are submitting framed work, we encourage the use of simple profile frames.

EXHIBITION DETAILS

- Delivery: All selected exhibiting artists will be notified of the designated drop off times via email.
- Shipping: Artists residing outside of the greater Los Angeles area must ship their artwork at their own cost and provide return shipping labels. The DAC Gallery cannot reimburse any incurred shipping costs on behalf of the artist(s).
- Installation: All artworks will be installed by DAC Gallery staff unless the artist is able to install their own work.
- Insurance for artwork will not be provided. The Gallery staff will make every effort to insure the handling of all artwork with the upmost care and professionalism, however, if you deem it necessary to insure your work, please make arrangements to do so through a third party.
- Consignment: Artists may choose to list their artworks for sale during the exhibition. The DAC makes no guarantees that the artwork will be sold.
- Commission: The DAC Gallery will take a 50% commission of any artwork sales.

Please do not call the gallery to check on the status of your submission. Selected artists will be notified via e-mail by **Friday, May 19, 2017**.
